This is a suggestion for personal items to pack for Nordtreff. This list should be adapted to any personal preferences you might have and should only be used as guidelines:

Gas bottles & Adapters

The Norwegian system for propane bottles is different from the system found in some of the other Nordic countries. Unfortunately, we do not have adapters or regulators you can borrow at the camp, but we can help the groups buy adapters. Nordtangen Camp is only a 5-minute drive from Gran city center, where several shops sell propane bottles.

Soap for Dishwashing and Hand Washing

The camp area at Nordtangen is next to a protected area. There is a designated area at the campsite for wastewater from washing dishes. It is important to use biodegradable soap.

Suppose you do not bring this from home. In that case, several brands are available in Norwegian supermarkets that can be used (Klar or Änglamark)

Information about the Hike / Away Mission

Information about the hike / away mission will be published on our website no later than Thursday, June 13. You will also find a Google form to sign up the patrols for different hikes / away missions on the website. We plan to team up two patrols for each hike / away mission. If you, as a leader, feel that the patrols can't do the hike alone, you are welcome to join them.

There will be a costume party day for the rover camp, and the team for this is Star Wars, so inform your rovers to bring or make their best Star Wars-related costumes.

The participants in the rover camp will prepare the same food as the scouts and should also bring equipment for making all their food. The current plan is to team up rovers for multiple countries in patrols.

The rovers will have the possibility of doing similar program activities as the scouts.

Information from the Program Department (JPL):

All patrols, scouts, and rovers must bring an empty bottle (approximately 1,5 liter). You will need this for the bottle rocket competition.
