

They pioneered the unique genre of "Hip-hop Banjo," a fusion of singing, rap, and instrumentation, prominently featuring guitars. 
"White Shadow" by Noaz Deshe (GE/TZ)

ALKASUS

Ahmed M Mohamed aka Medy (TZ)

Alkasus is essentially a Swahili drink, akin to the signature drinks like coffee or whisky in other parts of the world. Particularly along the Tanzanian coast, it's known as "Alkasus" or sometimes "Karakati Chai." It's a unique tea brewed with black tea and a blend of spices such as cardamom, cloves, and sometimes saffron, sweetened with condensed milk to create a flavorful beverage. Beyond being a drink, Alkasus holds significant cultural value for the coastal people and has gained popularity in East African coastal regions including Dar es Salaam, Tanga, Zanzibar, and Mombasa. It's enjoyed in social gatherings, especially in local men's spaces (Vijiweni), where discussions on various social issues, politics, and even religion take place. The Alkasus exhibition aims to introduce this cultural aspect to new audiences, exploring the topics discussed in these gatherings while honoring and preserving the rich Swahili culture. For locals, it aims to instill a sense of pride while celebrating the blend of tradition and contemporary life in Tanzania.

The artist, Ahmed M. Mohamed's creative process is defined by its interdisciplinary nature, its invitation for active participation, its layered symbolism, and the intricate weaving of cultural narratives. These unique aspects are showcased in this exhibition. He invites viewers into his artistic practices through the intersections of poetry, painting, and installations. Hailing from the bustling metropolis of Dar es Salaam, Ahmed has established himself as a luminary within the Tanzanian visual art scene. He has been creating works for over a decade, both as a solo artist and as a member of WACHATA CREW (WCT), a collective that explores urban life and expressions through Hip Hop and Graffiti art.
