

JUMATANO GROOVE #105 Mzungu Kichaa (TZ/DK): Crossing Cultures

Danish born Mzungu Kichaa, who has spent most of his life in Africa, proudly embraces his challenging stage name. This name, given to him as a symbol of cultural guardianship, translates to 'crazy white man', and carries complex socio-cultural significance. Scholars have delved into his impact on 'black' music, finding his story both captivating and motivational as he transcends linguistic, racial and cultural boundaries through his musical endeavours.

Mzungu Kichaa is a musical star in East Africa, where he broke through with the hit single "Jitolee" featuring Professor Jay. He was selected to become a judge on Bongo Star Search, the Tanzanian equivalent to X-Factor, and quickly became a public figure, particularly in Swahili speaking East Africa. He has collaborated with African stars such as Sauti Sol, Juma Nature and Fid-Q, as well as Scandinavian artists including Wafande, Kaka and Karen Mukupa.

Mzungu Kichaa has been nominated twice for a Danish Music Award, and his debut album Tuko Pamoja won him "best upcoming artist" at the Scandinavian African Achievement Awards. He has toured extensively in sub-Saharan Africa and in Europe, where his fan base is steadily growing. His dynamic and lively stage performance immerse audiences in deep-rooted syncopated rhythms welcoming them into the vibrant world of global music.

Bobi Wine: The People's President by Moses Bwayo (UG)

Born in the slums of Kampala, Bobi Wine, Ugandan opposition leader, former member of parliament, activist and national superstar musician, risks his life to fight the ruthless regime led by Yoweri Museveni. Museveni has been in power since 1986 and changed Uganda's constitution to enable him to run for yet another five-year term.

Running in the country's 2021 presidential elections, Bobi Wine uses his music to denounce the dictatorial regime and support his life mission to defend the oppressed and the voiceless people of Uganda. In this fight, he must also take on the country's police and military, which are not afraid to use violence and torture in a vain attempt to intimidate and silence him and his supporters.
