

#### UBUNTU An exhibition by Kukua x Womencraft

The Alliance Française exhibition in Dar es Salaam delves into Ubuntu—a philosophy of shared humanity—through the collaborative efforts of Womencraft and Kukua, whose artisans channel tradition into contemporary design. Womencraft, born from the resilience of refugee women and hosting communities, and Kukua, rooted in a French designer's 30-year journey, converge to reimagine Tanzanian furnishings through sustainable, locally sourced materials.

Each installation embodies Ubuntu's core: interconnectedness and mutual support. The Kizimkazi series presents a continuous, sweeping sofa, a metaphor for the unbroken connections within a community. The Pemba installation, with a Queen armchair surrounded by Maasai chairs, evokes tribal solidarity, centering shared identity. In the heart of the exhibit, WomenCraft's chairs and lighting form a circular constellation, each piece resonating with the strength of unity and resilience. Here, craftsmanship transcends function, inviting viewers to witness how art becomes a vessel for community, cohesion, and the spirit of belonging.

#### JUMATANO GROOVE #118 Henry Mkanyia : Jazz Guitar

Henry Mkanyia, born in 1950 in Masasi, southern Tanzania, began his professional music career in 1964 with the T.Y.L (Tanu Youth League) Band. In 1970, he moved to Dar es Salaam and joined Tanzania Jazz Band, before switching to the army band JKT Kimbunga Stereo in 1971. As a guitarist-soldier, he toured Zambia, Uganda during the Iddi Amin war, Tunisia, and Germany, sharing the stage with legendary bands like Bembea Jazz. In 1981, Mkanyia joined DDC Mlimani Park Orchestra, where he recorded some of the band's most popular albums and toured internationally. From 2008 to 2019, he performed and recorded with Swahili Blues, touring across Kenya, Uganda, and Ethiopia. Over the years, he has played alongside iconic musicians such as Frank Sinatra, Franco Makiadi, and Mulatu Astatke.
