1) Information Corner

Healthwatch Southend

If you ever encounter a problem with your GP practice, blood test clinic, physio service or indeed one of our three local hospitals: Southend, Basildon or Broomfield, did you know there is an independent, free, NHS watchdog service?

It's Healthwatch Southend. Paid for by Southend Borough Council - but completely independent - the service is managed by one of the UK's largest charities, Family Action. The Healthwatch team is based at The Children's Centre, off Woodgrange Drive (though currently mostly home working).

HWS has a staff of five (including a confidential health advocacy service), plus an advisory board, which meets at least once a month and holds public board meetings every three months. Because of the current pandemic, all Healthwatch Southend meetings are held by Zoom video.

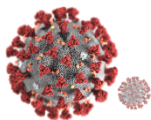

Weekly Briefing on Local Decisions & Actions re Coronavirus outbreak
2nd October 2020

Key updates/actions

- **Mobile testing site at Shoebury Park:** A mobile COVID-19 testing site has been set up in Shoebury Park for booked appointments. The additional testing site will be open two days of the week on a Tuesday and a Friday.
- **Flu vaccination:** We are jointly promoting the flu vaccination this autumn and winter with Southend NHS CCG. As part of this promotion and the Livewell launch, we spoke to Dr Pankhania about the flu vaccine, who needs it and why it's so important: [View the video on the Livewell Facebook page](#). Please share this if you can.
- **Test and Trace support payment:** People on a means-tested benefit and a low income who are advised by NHS Test and Trace to self-isolate, but are unable to work from home and will lose income as a result, will be eligible for the test and trace support payment scheme. This will be a one off £500 payment.

- **NHS COVID-19 app:** We are continuing to promote the national launch of the NHS COVID-19 app across a variety of channels. Residents across the country are being urged to download it and help protect themselves and their loved ones.

The national NHS Digital information shows information by time intervals (for example, 3-days, 7-days, 30-days, etc), as well as the total numbers and requests or referrals to NHS 111.

- **Support helpline for parents:** A support helpline has been set up for parents who have concerns about sending their children to school due to COVID-19. The helpline (01702 212520) operates from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

- **Out of hours**

Urgent issues arising out of hours should be reported to the out of hours service in accordance with standard practice.

The phone number is 01702 215000.

The out of hours service will then contact the relevant Council officer who is on-call or the relevant contractor such as Veolia. They also have access to the town link radio and CCTV.
