Dear Prime Minister,

Re: <u>Atrocities on Hindu Minorities in Bangladesh</u>

We, British Hindus, would like to draw your attention to the recent targeted acts of violence and atrocities perpetrated against the peaceful Hindu community in Bangladesh during the auspicious occasion of Durga Puja, a significant religious festival for Hindus worldwide.

## Scale of Violence

These barbaric attacks against this religious minority were relentless and lasted for over a week in Bangladesh. From 13<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> October 2021, it has emerged that in Bangladesh 315 Hindu temples were vandalised, nearly 1,500 Hindu homes and businesses were ransacked and over 23 Hindu women and girls were raped including a 10-year-old minor girl who succumbed to her injuries. There are also reports of many Hindus being killed and many still missing. Temples of global Hindu organisations like Ramakrishna Mission and ISKCON were particularly targeted. The initial response from the Bangladesh government and police was woefully inadequate. The Hindu community in Bangladesh is in a state of despair and destitution.

Such acts of violence are unfortunately not new against minorities in Bangladesh who suffer daily indignities for simply practicing their faith. Professor Abul Barkat of Dhaka University had pointed out that 11.3 million Hindus left Bangladesh between 1964 and 2013 (Ref: Dhaka Tribune, 20 November 2016) due to religious persecution. As a direct consequence, the Hindu population has declined from about 30% in 1947 to 8% in 2011.

## **Our Obligation**

We, the British Hindus are now greatly concerned about the safety of Hindus in Bangladesh and are seeking a response and condemnation by the British government of these horrific events. The UK has a proud record of defending universal human rights on the global stage. The UK continues to hand over hundreds of millions of pounds each year in aid to Bangladesh, with a significant increase in humanitarian aid spending. Bangladesh is also a trade partner it is, therefore, important to insist that the government reiterate their commitment to protecting its minorities and safeguards its human rights according to the UN charter. We believe it is incumbent on the British government to raise the issue of the pogroms against Hindus in Bangladesh and exert pressure and seek answers from the government of Bangladesh.

Hindus around the world protested on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2021 to highlight the persecution of Hindus in Bangladesh and to express solidarity with these victims of human rights violations.

## **Our Appeal**

We, therefore, appeal you to:

- 1. Strongly condemn this violence and ask the Bangladesh Government to take appropriate measures to protect its Hindu minorities and ensure their long-term protection and human rights.
- 2. Ensure that the Bangladesh Government follows through with their promise to punish those responsible for this violence, rehabilitate the victims and restore the Hindu temples and provide appropriate protection to the Hindus.
- 3. Ensure that Bangladesh abides by its commitment to human rights of minorities while discussing humanitarian aid and preferential trade agreements.

We hope that you will consider this matter urgently, take appropriate actions to allay the concerns of the British Hindu community.
