

Some terminology is needed

- Solvability – contexts about WHAT (initiative) to do, and contexts about finding a solution to the WHAT, or if it is possible to find a solution at all, i.e., like in the complex context
- Insolvability¹⁾ – a context where it is impossible to find a solution to an issue (=effect)
- Objectivity – $1+1=2$
- Subjectivity – opinion when no objectivity exist, "Blue is the most beautiful color"
- Unobjectivity – $1+1=3$

1) One way to think about Insolvability is the unknown unknowns, where we really are when having root causes, even though we think that we have everything under control in our way of working. When we are realizing that we are in Insolvability, we will have a transition (hopefully short) through the state of chaos, before we are finding the root causes from the effects.
