

**Report to Landsort Bird Observatory Board on the monitoring of nest boxes in
the spring of 2016
Prepared by Chris Sharpe – June 2016**

A total of 217 boxes were located and in a good enough condition to be used for breeding. This represents 86% of the boxes marked on the map. Of these 71 (32.7%) were occupied this year.

A summary of occupied boxes where chicks were ringed is shown below:
