SEMMS Relief Road

I am writing in support of plans to build a new relief road between the A6 and Manchester Airport.

There is currently no direct east-west transport link through south east Greater Manchester and Cheshire East. This contributes to congestion and means that people and goods cannot move easily, directly and efficiently between eastern Cheshire and the south of Manchester.
