Chris,

There are two matters on which the application reaching the above Committee dates rely:

1. Updated Justification for Loss of open Space - we hope to have this completed today/tomorrow.
2. Sensitivity test to understand impact of further children arriving from Tameside - we hope that we have already covered this, FM is just checking with Donna on figures, and if positive will then get a formal response out tomorrow.

We hope that this information will be submitted well before Friday 13 July, to allow Jim Seymour to undertake reconsultation for 14 days in advance of the Area Committee.

For information, I am on holiday the week of 30 July to 7August.

There is an opportunity to address the Area Committee on 30 July, but not the Planning Committee on 23 August.

Steve Lamb did suggest that someone addresses the Area Committee, as it is highly likely that Sheila Oliver will be objecting to the proposal and speaking. Our presentation should put across the salient planning and education points from the submissions to date, highlighting the positive benefits of the proposals.

In terms of the Area and Planning Committee Members, once we have confirmation that the proposal is to proceed to these Committees, it may be worth considering whether your/Donna's Members can apply any political pressure to the Committee Members, through lobbying in advance?
