



RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



All Welsh Inhand Affiliated Classes Will Be Judged Under The Rules Of WPCS

- Rosettes Awarded 1st-6th Place
- All Exhibitors In The Affiliated Welsh Breed Classes Must Abide By The Current WPCS Judging And Showing Rules
- Exhibitors Numbers To Be Collected On The Show Day From The Secretary's Office. Exhibitors Will Be Responsible For Ensuring That The Correct Numbers Are Worn In The Appropriate Classes.
- The Show Committee Reserves The Right To Cancel, Amalgamate Or Divide Any Class Or Classes.
- The Judge's Decision Is Final
- The Show Committee, Judges Or Officials, Or Their Associates Will Accept No Responsibility For Any Loss, Damage Or Injury To Any Persons, Animals Or Property Howsoever Caused. It Is Advised To Have Insurance
- Any One Causing Disturbance And Any Act Of Discourteous Behaviour May Result In Being Asked To Leave The Showground Immediately.
- Dogs MUST Be Kept On Leads At All Times
- Hard Hats Must Be Worn At ALL Times When Riding Ponies And Cobs On The Showground
- Exhibitors Are Asked To Please Help Keep The Showground Tidy And To Take Their Litter Home With Them
- Please Supervise Your Children At All Times For Their Own Safety
- The Committee Cannot Be Held Responsible For Any Error In The Catalogue And Reserve The Right To Cancel Or Amend In Any Way
- Young Handlers – Under The Age Of 14 Must Wear A British Standard Hard Hat, Gloves And Suitable Footwear. Age As Of 1st January. No Colts Or Stallions, Parents Or Guardians To Be Advised That The Animal Must Be Of A Suitable Height And Temperament For The Handler And Class.

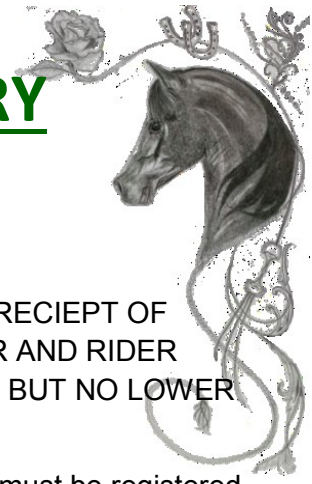

- STRICTLY NO SPECTATORS
- SELF SERVICE COLLECTION OF YOUR ENTRY NUMBER(S)
- CLASSES MAY BE LIMITED NUMBERS – PLEASE SEND YOUR ENTRIES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE
- PLEASE USE YOUR OWN TOILET FACILITES WHERE POSSIBLE
- FACE MASKS OR SHIELDS ARE ADVISED
- SANITIZERS WILL BE LEFT AROUND PLEASE USE WHEN POSSIBLE
- EACH COMPETITOR CAN TRAVEL WITH THEIR FAMILY FROM THE SAME HOUSEHOLD, OR MEET WITH ONE PERSON OUTSIDE OF THEIR HOME FOR HELP WITH THEIR TEAM ON THE DAY

- TAKE YOUR RUBBISH AWAY WITH YOU

RIDDEN - WPCS PERFORMANCE MEDAL TERMS

-PERFORMANCE MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION, UPON RECEIPT OF WPCS MEMBERSHIP CARD BEING PRODUCED IN THE RING OF BOTH THEIR OWNER AND RIDER
-MEDALS CAN BE AWARDED IN MIXED COMPANY TO THE HIGHEST PLACED WELSH BUT NO LOWER THAN FOURTH

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless overstamp into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the **NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3rd – 5th August 2021.**

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS SILVER MEDAL CHAMPIONSHIP ROSETTES: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the **NPS Summer Championship Show 3rd – 5th August 2021**
