Update – Changes to the arrangements for the start of the January term

Following extensive discussions, between the Welsh Government and local authorities, a common approach for the return to school in January has been agreed. With transmission levels continuing to increase across Wales, it has been decided that there will be some flexibility built in at the beginning of term.

The school will remain closed to pupils during the first week and will continue to provide distance learning from Monday 4 January. From Wednesday 6 January, the school will provide a provision for vulnerable learners and critical worker childcare, where we have the capacity to do so.

In light of the increasing transmission, critical worker childcare will be prioritised to frontline blue light services, NHS, school workers and social care as part of the critical workforce, only where all other childcare options have been exhausted. However, this may need to be reviewed depending on community transmission rates between now and the start of term.
