NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The applying prescriptions of the Danish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 The Rules are changed as follows:
- The preamble to Part 4 will be changed, to state that the obligation to wear personal buoyancy when flag Y is displayed not only applies while racing.
 - 14.1. The following deadlines apply: 15 minutes for 1th. boat to mark 1 or 45 minutes for 1th. boat to finish. Any deviation in sailing time can not form the basis for requesting reimbursement. This amends rule 62.1 (a).
 - Class 1st mark deadline 1st boat in finish
 - Rules 35 and A4 will be changed to state, that boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.
 - Rule 60.1(a) will be changed to state, that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches for some specific parts of the sailing instructions.
 - Rules 61.3 and 62.2 will be changed to fix the protest time to 60 minutes for competitors, protest committee as well as race committee.
 - Rule 66 will be changed to shorten the time limit for reopening protest hearings.
 - Rule A4 will be changed by stating, that at boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Int. CB66 Class, holding a valid measurement certificate.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by sending mail with registration to email: jesper@arentoft.dk not later than 22 September 2020 and pay the entry fee DKK 1.200,- at **mobilpay to 40104076** before that date. However, foreign competitors must **pay in cash (Danish Kroner 1.200,-)** before the first start.

The registration e-mail to jesper@arentoft.dk must contain:

- **Boat number and name**
 - **Skipper and club membership**
 - **Crew 1 and club membership**
 - **Crew 2 and club membership**
- 2.3 At registration, competitors shall present:
- evidence of current membership of a sailing club;
 - evidence of an insurance against third-party claims in the sum of at least Euro 1.5 million;
 - a valid measurement certificate as required by the class rules.

3 FEES

Entry fee is: **DKK 1.200.**

The fee includes a breakfast and lunch for Sunday and an after-racing-beer on both days. Please note that there is no breakfast or lunch Saturday.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration and "come together beer and drinks" at Hornbæk Bådeklub club house: Friday 25 September at 17:00-19:00 Hrs. and Saturday 26 September at 8:00-9:00 Hrs. in the office located on the first floor in the club house.
- 4.2 Dates of racing: 26 and 27 September 2020. Up to 12 races are scheduled.
Warning signal for the 1st race of the day is: Saturday: 11:00 Hrs. Sunday 10:00 Hrs.
- 4.3 The attention signals for the following races will be made as soon as practicable.
- 4.4 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 15:00 Hrs.
- 4.5 Hornbæk Bådeklub will try to setup a dinner arrangement for Saturday evening. More info will follow.

5 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate at registration. In addition, the following measurements and control requirements apply: Spot checking may be performed on and off water during the regatta. A boat found to be non-conforming will be protested.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on Facebook **CB66 DK Sejler til Sejler (Intern)** from 20. September 2020.

7 VENUES

7.1 The regatta harbour will be Hornbæk Harbour.

7.2 Courses will be sailed on the waters of Hornbæk.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Up/Down Format with starboard rounding as described in the Sailing Instructions. The planned sailing time for the first boat will be 20 minutes.

At the regatta, also Contender boats will participate.

9 SCORING

9.1 One race is required to constitute a series.

When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores

10 SAFETY

Danish legislation requires every boat to be equipped with personal buoyancy for the number of persons on board a boat at any time.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall register at the office before the first race, display national identification letters clearly visible and stay at least 50 meters from any racing boat.

12 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will as a minimum be awarded for the first three boats.

Prize giving will take place soonest possible after racing on the Sunday.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. (See rule 4, Decision to Race.) The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1,500,000 per event or the equivalent.
