The Centre for Deaf and Hard of Hearing People (CfD) is a charity, which has been delivering services in Bristol for over 140 years.

We provide support for adults with all types of hearing loss, from Deaf sign language users to the many people who become Hard of Hearing as they age.

We focus on removing communication barriers so that Deaf and Hard of Hearing people can participate more fully in all aspects of their day-to-day lives.

- Do you often miss people coming to the front door because you don't hear the bell?
- Do you worry that you might miss the sound of an emergency alarm?
- Do you have to turn the TV up to full volume to hear it or only watch it with subtitles so as not to disturb people?
- Do you miss out on conversations with family and friends because you can't hear them fully?

- Personal listeners

About our equipment service

We provide an equipment service for Deaf and Hard of Hearing people living in Bristol, which is funded by Bristol City Council.

We have a range of listening aid equipment, which can help keep you independent and improve your quality of life through better communication with friends and family.

One of our trained officers can visit you at your home to demonstrate and install the equipment for you. Depending on eligibility, some products are free of charge and others are available to buy.
