And here's a quick summary of key dates:

- Monday 8th April (don't delay!): deadline for video auditions (required for anyone wanting to be considered for a role as a Workhouse Kid, a member of Fagin's Gang, Oliver, the Artful Dodger, Bet, or Nancy.
- Wed 1st or Thu 2nd May: pre-audition rehearsals for under 16s
 Sunday 5th May: under 16s auditions
 - Wed 8th or Thu 9th May: adult pre-audition rehearsals

- Adult auditions: Sun 12th May
- 21st May 13th September: rehearsal period (Principals on Tuesdays; Juniors and Fagin on Wednesdays; adult company on Thursdays; some Sunday rehearsals; no rehearsals during summer school holidays)
- Full company rehearsals, Tech and performance period: Friday 20th September to Saturday 12th October (no performances on Mondays or Tuesdays).

This will be a great opportunity to work with new professionals and perform in an 800 seater venue, and we're looking forward to seeing lots of new and familiar faces involved!
