OUR CAST AUDITIONS

We are now looking to cast all other parts and chorus/ensemble for our production of Hunchback of Notre Dame. Auditions are on **Sunday 5th September 2021 10am -4pm at Philip Morant Dance Studio (part of their Q theatre)**. We are holding 2 pre-audition workshops on **Monday 30th August and Thursday 2nd September 7.30pm-10pm at The Hythe Community Centre**.

Anyone aged 16 years or over interested in joining COS and auditioning for this production can come along to one of these workshops to learn about the production, meet the creative team and learn some of the key audition pieces. It is not compulsory to attend one of these workshops before auditioning, though you may find them useful in preparing for your audition. However, you will need to become a member (which costs only £10 for the year!) and complete an audition form in advance in order to attend one of the workshops and audition on the 5th September.

DISNEY'S ANIMATED THE HUNCHBACK OF Notre Dame

Hugo's novel has inspired numerous adaptations. Perhaps the most well-known of these adaptations is Disney's 1996 animated flm, which began production in 1993, when Walt **Disney Feature Animation** development executive David Stainton was looking for material to adapt into an animated musical. The team at Disney Animation felt that it was always important to tackle a new challenge with each flm; inspired by the opportunity to adapt a literary masterpiece that is sophisticated and serious in tone,

Disney quickly put the flm into production with directors Garv Trousdale and Kirk Wise, who had previously directed Beauty and the Beast together. Joining them would be composer Alan Menken, writing music for his sixth Disney animated flm, and lyricist Stephen Schwartz who had previously collaborated with Disney and Menken on Pocahontas. After Pocahontas, Schwartz and Menken were offered a choice of a few ideas for their next project and were immediately attracted to The Hunchback of Notre Dame.

Schwartz explains, "I liked the underlying themes (the idea of social outcasts and the worth of people being different than what society sees on the surface) and the struggle of Quasimodo to break free of the psychological dominance of Frollo."
