# The Production Team director

Katie has been singing from the age of 5, plays the piano & guitar and writes her own songs, which she has performed solo & in bands locally. She has also performed locally with Platform Musicals, COS & Encore company singers. She has been a member of COS for over 18 years, performing in many different shows and has served on the Executive committee for the last 9 years. She became Chair of Colchester Operatic Society in June 2019. She made her directing debut in 2017 with the COS concert "Seasons with Swing" which was performed at the Headgate and the Mercury Theatre, then later directed & choreographed the COS concert "Dare to be Different" performed at the Headgate Theatre in February 2020. During the Pandemic she ensured the Society continued producing musical works by creating the concept of a scripted pre-recorded online musical concert named "The Show Must Go Online", which she directed, performed in, and edited together herself working within lockdown and varying covid restrictions. Iconic sees her return to the traditional role of directing and choreographing a live concert.

Formed in 1970, Freddie Mercury, Brian May, Roger Taylor and John Deacon were one of the biggest stadium rock bands of all time, selling between 250-300 million records. Their incredible 1985 Live Aid performance was recreated in the 2018 biopic Bohemian Rhapsody starring Oscar winning Rami Malek. Many of these songs were adapted into the acclaimed musical We Will Rock You, written by Ben Elton in 2002, originally running for 12 years in London.

#### Jim Steinman/Andrew Lloyd Webber - Whistle Down The Wind

**Keys To The Vaults of Heaven** 

Rock musician and lyricist Jim Steinman collaborated with musical theatre royalty, Andrew Lloyd Webber to compose an adaptation of the 1961 film about a man on the run hiding in a small religious community in Louisiana. The musical is mostly known for Boyzone's chart-topping cover of No Matter What, released as part of the show's celebrity concept album.

#### Jim Steinman/Meat Loaf – Bat Out of Hell

However, Steinman is most known for his collaboration with American rock singer Meat Loaf, writing the album Bat Out of Hell in 1977, which sold over 43 million copies worldwide. The musical adaptation of the album trilogy combined with the story of Peter Pan premiered (as most UK shows do) at the Manchester Opera House in 2017 before transferring to London's West End and touring the world.

#### Frankie Valli/Four Seasons - The Jersey Boys

The Tony award-winning jukebox musical The Jersey Boys tells the story of Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons, both on and off stage with their incredible vocal harmonies, and is currently playing at the Trafalgar Theatre, London.

The 2021 biopic Respect featured Jennifer Hudson as the Queen of Soul and followed the rise of Aretha Franklin's career from a child singing in her father's church choir to her international superstandom. Franklin passed away in 2018, over thirty years since she became the first female artist to be inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

This Liverpudlian band needs little introduction. They are regarded as the most influential band of all time and were integral to the development of 1960s counterculture and popular music's recognition as an art form. Supported by Abbey Road producer and arranger, George Martin, they developed their sound from late 1950s Skiffle to American influenced Rock 'n' Roll by the mid-1960s. A number of Beatles musicals and films have told their "fab" story.

#### **Bob Dylan – Girl From The North Country**

One of the greatest folk singer/songwriters of all time (and a member of the Traveling Wilburys), the genius of Bob Dylan is celebrated in this new musical which cleverly sets beautiful arrangements of his songs against a new story by Conor McPherson, combining multiple storylines and characters against the squalor of the Great Depression.

Former member of Colchester Operatic Society/CO2, John Dagleish won the 2015 Olivier Award for Best Actor in a Musical for the production Sunny Afternoon, which celebrates the life and music of Ray Davies and The Kinks in 1960s London. John's sister, Emma, still performs with COS and is one of our Iconic concert cast.

Barry, Robin and Maurice Gibb were born on the Isle of Man, moved to Manchester then to Australia but returned in 1967 with new hit songs such as Massachusetts, and by 1977 were the kings of Disco with their chart-topping album soundtrack to the John Travolta movie Saturday Night Fever and infamous vocal style. Their song-writing process for other artists included the songs Islands in the Stream, Chain Reaction, Grease, Woman in Love and Heartbreaker but can you name the singers who performed them?

During the mid-20th Century, outstanding songwriter Carole King composed over one hundred hit songs, along with her then husband Gerry Goffin. These were featured alongside the songs by Barry Mann and Cynthia Weill in the musical Beautiful about her life and career. Combining this with the music of The Drifters, written by many of the same artists, we have created a musical battle of the sexes and a tale as old as time.

Following the fatigue of Beatlemania on their concert touring experience, the Beatles retreated to the recording studio, embracing the psychedelic late 1960s with ground-breaking albums including Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band. They have most recently been celebrated in Peter Jackson's extended documentary Get Back about their final months and the historic rooftop performance in London in January 1969.

In 1999, British playwright Catherine Johnson, director Phyllida Lloyd and producer Julie Craymer created Mamma Mia! the musical based on the hits of Swedish supergroup ABBA. This spawned a pair of hit movies starring Meryl Streep and Amanda Seyfried. Fans are currently flocking to see Voyage, the multimedia concert performance using motion caption animated ABBAtars with a 10-piece live band in a purpose-built venue in London.

In a career spanning over 6 decades, Sir Elton John has wowed audiences with his flamboyant concert experiences featuring so many hit songs, written with his musical collaborator, lyricist Bernie Taupin. The 2019 biopic Rocket Man explores his life and pop career but he is equally successful as a musical theatre composer, often working with Tim Rice on The Lion King, Aida, Billy Elliot and The Road to Eldorado in their various animated and live action productions.

**Encore: Whitney Houston - The Body Guard** 

One Moment in Time

Based upon the 1992 Kevin Costner/Whitney Houston movie, The Body Guard stage musical features many hit songs from the late singer/songwriter, known as "The Voice" who had sold over 200 million records worldwide. Our encore is One Moment in Time, which was written for the 1988 Summer Olympics and reached No. 1 in the UK charts at that time.


