Several techniques will be demonstrated and practiced. Emphasis will be placed on the facilitating (driving) use of music in therapy and the role of the music therapist as musician, therapist and clinical scientist. How does the use of music and the application of therapeutic intervention techniques vary in this model, as compared to that of a psychotherapeutic approach? Through an in-depth examination of the development of NMT, its underlying concepts and intervention techniques, trained music therapists will be given the opportunity to reflect upon this question as well as their own clinical skills.
