

EVENTLOCATION MOTORWERK BERLIN





LOCATION



The Motorwerk is characterized by an original industrial architecture and the rough, warm character of a production hall from the early 20th Century.

With its impressive dimensions, it is one of the few off-locations in Berlin, which has preserved its appearance until today.



It covers a length of 90 meters, an area of about 2,000 square meters and offers ideal conditions for concerts, fashion shows, gettogethers, dinners, product launches, fairs and exhibitions.





LOCATION



Particularly impressive is the gallery with about 1,000 square meters.

A stage of 80 square meters can be moved on rails through the hall.

The front building has two floors with over 400 square meters of space.

A large outdoor area next to the building can also be used.

Other areas on the site are available on request.










PLAN MOTORWERK BERLIN


























HISTORY



The event location "Motorwerk Berlin" is situated at Industriebahn Berlin. It is a former industrial facility built in the early 1920s in brick stone.

The landmarked building has been constructed as industrial premises for Ziehl-Abegg Elektrizitätsgesellschaft, which has been founded in 1910 by Emil Ziehl and Eduard Abegg. In times of technological progress, Emil Ziehl developed ground-breaking special purpose electric engines. They have been manufactured in those premises since 1921 until WWII. From this former engine production the name "Motorwerk Berlin" (engine factory Berlin) is derived.






HISTORY



During GDR times the area has been used by VEB ISOKOND. The VEB ("volkseigene Betrieb" = peoples owned company) produced electric appliance there and has been specialized in capacitors.

After the wall came down, Motorwerk Berlin was known under the name "Die Halle" for concerts and events. Artists including Kraftwerk, Motörhead, Velvet Underground, the Red Hot Chili Peppers, the Ramones and many others performed here. In 1991 the first techno event named Mayday with famous DJs like Westbam, Sven Väth and Marusha took place here. Thus, the Motorwerk is a symbol of the reunited Berlin and the awakening of the energetic 1990s.

Today the Motorwerk is used especially for corporate events, exhibitions and presentations.

The Motorwerk is located in the north of Berlin, only 10 minutes from the trendy Prenzlauer Berg and accessible from the central parts of the city by car in a few minutes.

15 minutes from Alexanderplatz 25 minutes from Central Station ("Hauptbahnhof") 35 minute drive from Messe Berlin

From S-Bahnhof Friedrichstraße: Tram 12 to Pasedagplatz (5 min walking distance)
