Volunteer Stewards

welcome visitors to the museum. There are always at least two stewards on duty. Stewards cover one 2 to 2.5 hour session every 2 weeks. That is not a huge commitment, and there will be opportunities to do more. A rota is issued in advance so you can plan ahead. We don't ask for any previous knowledge, just good people skills and an interest in the town or history in general. You'll be shown what to do before you start

and there'll be plenty of opportunities to build on your knowledge and talents as you go along.

The Museum opens from April to October currently 2 days a week... but with more stewards... we could open more!

Volunteer Archivists / **Volunteer Researchers** help sort and catalogue our extensive archive and artefact collection and research into topics of local interest and help answer the many queries we get from all over the world.

We are currently undertaking a project to review our archives, checking and sorting the contents of each box and entering the details onto a database. If you'd like to help with the sorting but don't fancy the data entry, or vise-versa, let us know which you would prefer and we can put together teams with complementary skills.

This work goes on all year round.
