**Statement of research interests:** The overall aim of my research is to understand the risk factors for suicidal behaviors across lifespan relying on data from population-based longitudinal studies and innovative methods. My research is interdisciplinary and builds on different research traditions, including psychiatric epidemiology, developmental psychopathology, behavioral genetics, and data science/biostatistics. My research has contributed to the understanding of **1)** the developmental origins of suicide, **2)** the association of childhood irritability and depression with youth suicide risk, **3)** the epidemiology of suicide in high-income and low- and middle-income

countries, **4**) the association of substance use, especially cannabis use, with depression and suicide, **5**) the long-term economic and social outcomes of youth suicide attempt and related mental health problems.
