1. INTRODUCTION

The Engelholm BMX club and the city of Ängelholm are proud to welcome you to the Sibirien BMX arena. Engelholms BMX club has a long history of hosting and organising BMX race events on both national and international level.

The track in Ängelholm was built by Elite Trax in 2013, and the same year did we get the opportunity to host two rounds of the European Cup.

In 2015 we were awarded to host the UCI BMX Supercross World Cup, in 2015 and 2019 we host the Nordic- and Baltic Championship and in 2025 we hosted two rounds of the European Cup.

2. TRACK DETAILS

The Sibirien BMX Arena features a Challenge track with 5 m start hill, ProGate and Championship track with 8 m start hill and ProGate. The track is 400 m long with asphalt bends and a pro section starting from the 8 m hill continuing into the second and third straight.



3. THE CITY OF ÄNGELHOLM

Ängelholm is a town in the southern part of Sweden that is called Skåne.

The city has a population of 45.000. The perfect location close to the sea, forests and hills, enjoying life is easy – every day! The Rönne river floats through the town centre and enters the sea in Skälderviken, adding to the pleasant atmosphere. Six kilometers of sandy beaches, the Kronoskogen forest and the picturesque town centre are other appealing features of Ängelholm.

The town was founded by Danish king Christian II in 1516 and started attracting large numbers of tourists at the beginning of the 20th century, when one of Sweden's first urban summer residential areas – Ängelholm's Havsbad – were planned and built. It is also here, in Ängelholm, in a state-of-the-art facility in southern Sweden, that Koenigsegg creates a handful of bespoke Hypercars every year.

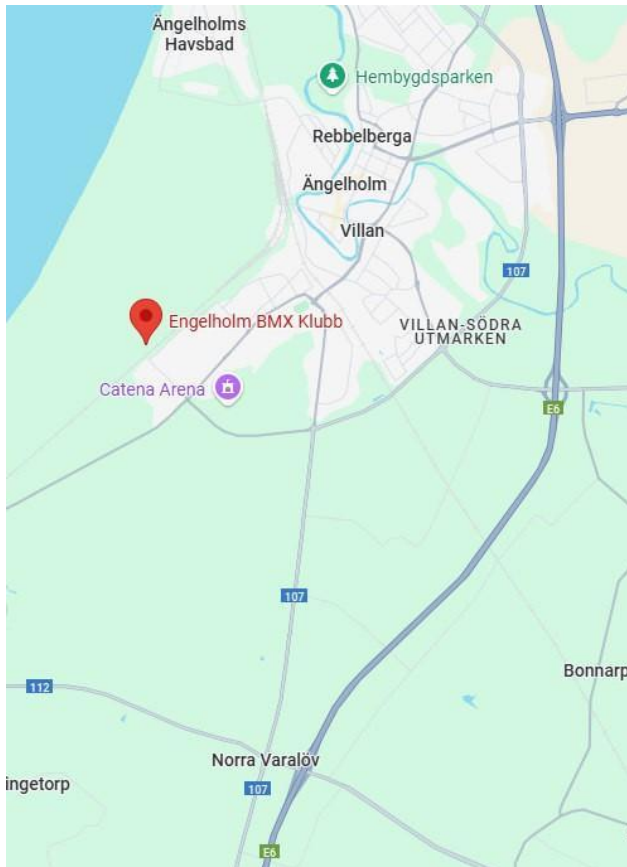

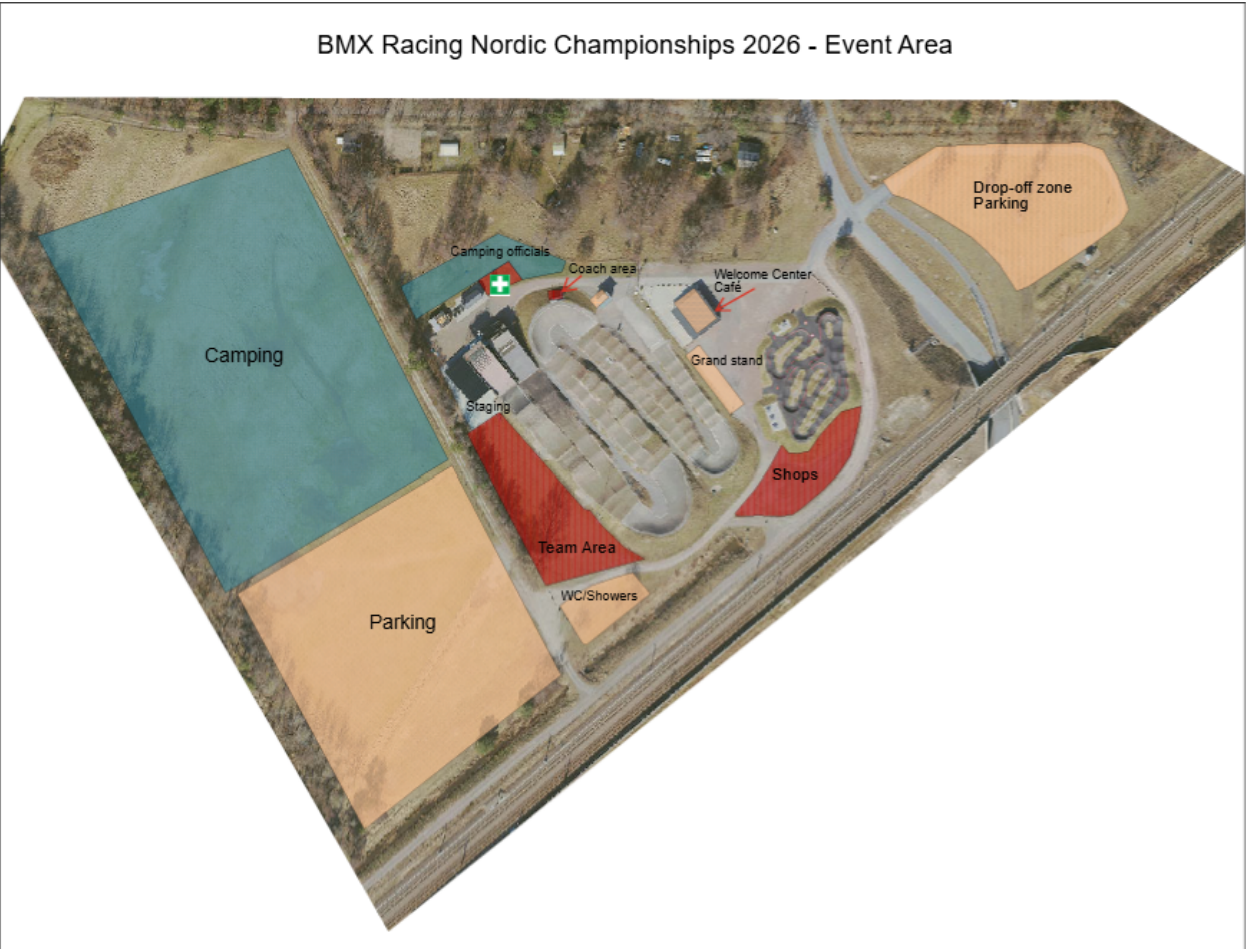

All team managers must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome center to confirm their riders participation for the event and receive accreditations.

9. RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

Riders categories: as set above.

Event format: For all categories scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027 quarter of the UCI BMX Rulebook. A and B finals in all challenge classes with final rounds (9 or more riders confirmed).

The posting of race information including startlists and results will be done electronically at event. We will use <https://our.sqorz.com> for all race info.

Rider's equipment:

All riders must use numberplate and side plate. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.

All Championship and Challenge riders must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country. National champions can use National champion jersey.

If a Championship rider is National Champion in their class, this rider must wear either:

- the jersey awarded by the federation,
- a replica of that jersey with publicity in the spaces allowed by the regulations,
- their normal jersey with the left sleeve designed to look like the flag of their country

Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the Nordic BMX commission allows the PCP in agreement with the National Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

10. Numberplates, Sideplates and Transponders

All participants must bring their own numberplate, sideplate and transponder. These will not be provided by the organizers. This is imperative to ensure that accurate personal details are provided during the registration process.

For all riders across all categories the use of a transponder, numberplates and sideplates is mandatory due to timekeeping requirements. (For Kids class transponder is not required)

The designated transponder is the Mylaps Prochip www.mylaps.com Riders are responsible for ensuring their transponder is functional and has an active subscription, as transponders will not be available for rent.

All riders are responsible for checking their transponders at the track during Saturday practice at www.our.sqorz.com
