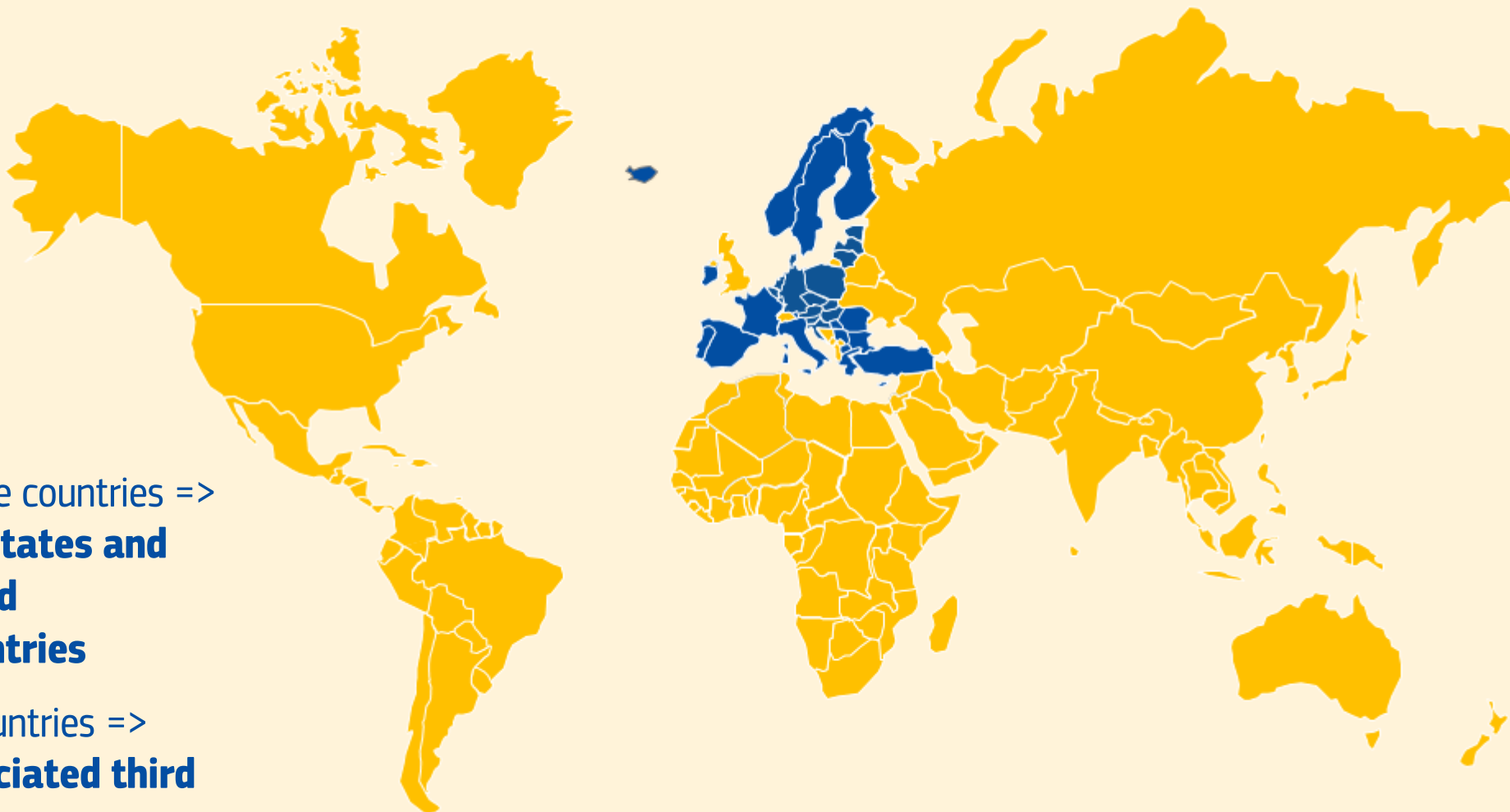


Erasmus Mundus since 2004

Applications EMJM 2021- Involvement of third country institutions not associated to the Programme

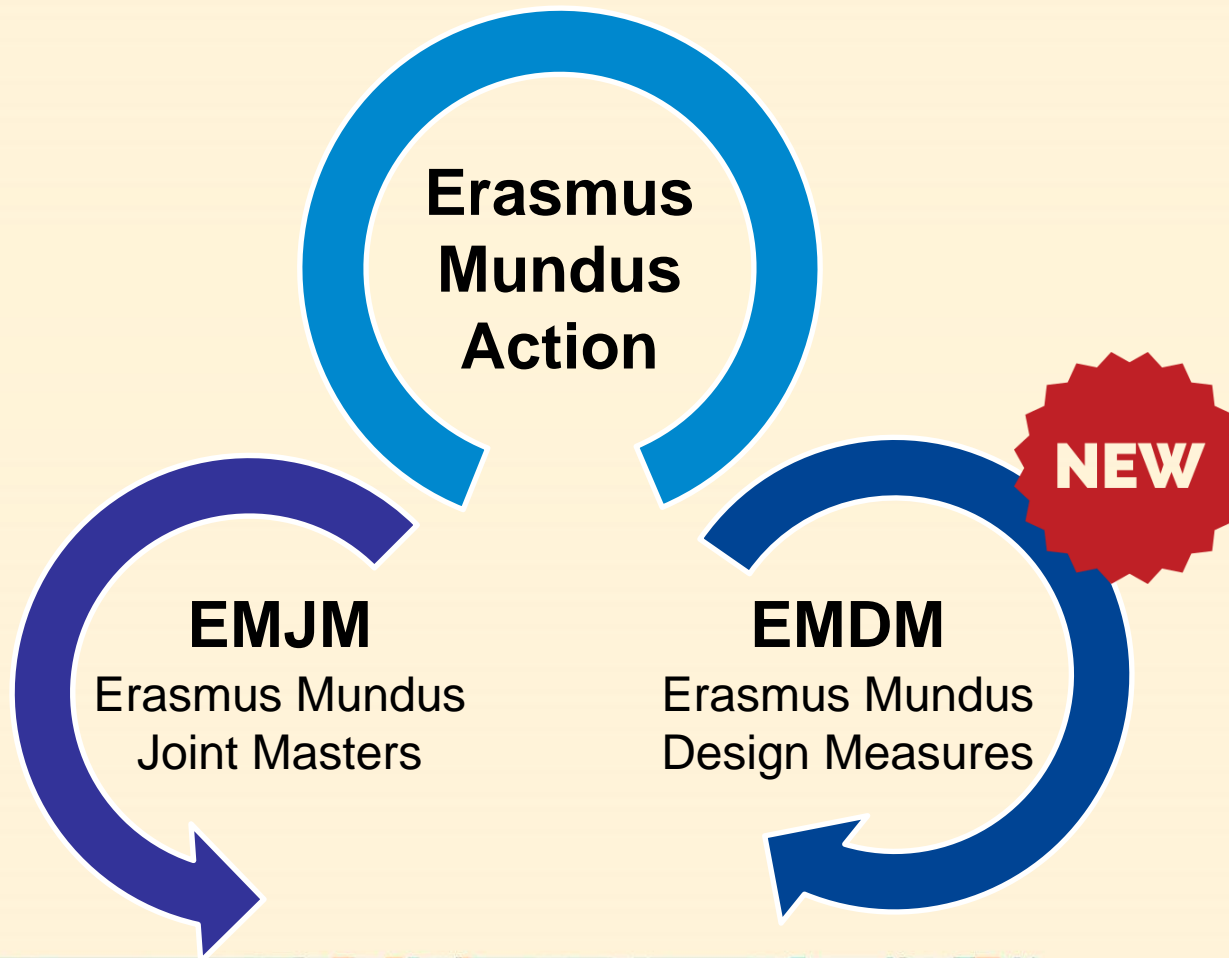
70 EMJM
Proposals

- **70 HEIs/coordinators** → **3** third country HEIs not associated to the Programme
- **238 full partners** → **31** third country HEIs not associated to the Programme
- **864 associated partners** → **320** institutions from third countries not associated to the Programme

=> Average size per proposal ≈ 16
