We will save your information about the past so that it can be useful and of benefit to the future. You can bestow the material on us, deposit it, or let the archive copy it.

Which materials are we interested in?

We are interested in all kinds of materials, i.e. documents, maps, diaries, photos and so on, both from private persons, clubs and firms.

What happens with your material?

The material will be recorded, packed in special archive boxes and stored in the best possible way, so that it can also be found in a hundred years.

Furthermore, the material will be recorded electronically to make it available online on the homepage *arkiv.dk*.

It is hard to know what might have our interest in a hundred years, but you'd better ask us once too much than once too little.

Is your material safe?

It is safer than you think.

You deside whether the material you give us is to be made public. If you think that your material is too private for everybody to see, it can be held in trust for a shorter or a longer period. Thus it will not be available online on *arkiv.dk* either.

Furthermore, the archives are covered by certain laws and regulations about storage and accessibility.
