Christer Olsson was sent by the Swedish Floorball Association to Singapore in 1998 to develop the game of floorball and to coach the National Men's Team from January – May 1998.

He has been working closely with Singapore Floorball Association as a part-time international instructor for five years to assist Singapore to build and develop the coaching programme - he conducted courses to develop coaches in a Train the Trainers Floorball Course. He also conducted the first ever floorball coaching course in Asia.

During his stay in Singapore he had met up with the deputy director of Co-curricular Activities Branch (CCAB) of Ministry of Education, Mr Ong Lye Huat. As a result of the meeting, Mr Ong become the SFA Vice President and the SFA official address was CCAB and that's when floorball has slowly been introduced to schools in Singapore.

Christer, as the National Coach for the National Men team, led the team at the World Floorball Championship 1998 at Prague.
