It is also a proof of the crimes of ethnic cleansing and genocide against the Palestinian people that date back to the days when Israel was established.

It is time for the international community to take concrete and immediate action to address an injustice that has lasted too long.

We, the General Union of the Palestinian Communities in Europe, call upon all peace and justice loving peoples of the world and the European Union in particular to support Amnesty International's Report and to bring it to the ICC with a view to holding Israel accountable of all the crimes that it has committed against the Palestinian People.
