

Keeping Safe During Winter **East Lavington Parish Council**

To all residents where severe winter conditions would be an issue for mobility or health.

“Severe winter conditions” are defined as temperatures below -2C and or 50mm of snow.

The following details in the table below will be supported by your Parish Council in the event of “Severe winter conditions” arising.

Conditions	Actions	Support from ELPC
Snowfall of 50mm	If not safe for you or neighbour to clear contact ELPC	ELPC arrange clearance for safe passage when no action by others
-2C and or wind chill for freezing conditions	ditto	ditto
Loss of water or Energy supply	Contact provider see list below	ELPC to follow up to support your emergency.
Medical attention	Contact GP or NHS 111 service. If urgent or emergency contact 999	ELPC to arrange transport in when no other agency is available.
Unable to collect medication during these conditions	Redirect medication to Graffham Village Shop.	ELPC to arrange collection
