

BULKY WASTE/WOOD

Wood and metals are being recycled the rest converted to electricity. Bulky waste can be mattresses, carpets and construction waste from DIY*. Wood are eg furniture

and pallets must be placed separately.
* Soil, stone and gravel as well as sanitary equipment, roofing tiles, bricks, concrete etc. Must be brought to the recycling station.



→ Bulky waste/wood can be handed in at the allocated room ("Storskrald") in the shed by the gate. Notice: Boards etc. must be disassembled or cut to max. 1.2 meters length.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

For treatment under controlled conditions. Hazardous waste is eg chemicals and poisons, low-energy bulbs, fluorescent tubes, paint, batteries, accumulators and spray

cans. Products and empty containers marked with these symbols are hazardous wastes.



→ Batteries must go in the green metal containers by the garbage sheds. Additional hazardous waste has to be locked away in the small green boxes located at every shed

Wastematerials can be recycled if you sort your waste correctly. Waste is value.

CARDBOARD

Recycled in new products.

Cardboard is eg cardboard boxes without styrofoam, corrugated board, carton, packaging for toys and toothpaste etc.

Cardboard and carton must be clean and folded flat before drop-off.



→ There are 1-2 containers for cardboard related rubbish at each garbageshed in the backyard

PAPER

Recycled in new products.

Newspapers and magazines, advertising materials, envelopes, also window envelopes,

books, including phone books, writing and drawing paper.

No need to remove clips or tape.



→ There are 1-2 containers for paper related rubbish at each garbageshed in the backyard

GLASS, BOTTLES AND JARS

Is refilled or are turned into new jars.

Glass, bottles and jars are eg wine and liquor bottles, food

jars, drinking glass and cullets from above items.

Food jars must be empty and can be with the lid.



→ There is one container for glass related rubbish at each garbageshed in the backyard

RESIDUAL WASTE

Converted into electricity and district heating. Residual waste can be milk and juice cartons, pizza boxes' and other greasy cardboard and paper, diapers, hygiene

waste, etc., styrofoam, animal litter and vacuum bags.

All residual waste must be properly packed in closed bags.



→ There are 6 containers for residual waste at each garbageshed in the backyard

ELECTRONIC WASTE

Contained materials are recycled in new products.

Electronic waste is eg phones and chargers, electric tooth brushes, electric toys, irons,

small kitchen utensils such as hand mixers, blenders, etc., postcards, shoes and ties with light or music.

Place large items separately.



→ Smaller electronic objects: Use the containers with orange lids at the garbage sheds. Larger electronic objects: Use the electronic waste room in the shed by the gate.

PLASTIC

Recycled in new products.

Plastic is eg plastic bottles without deposit/return system, bottles used for beverages, shampoo, cleaning detergents, trays from fruit,

ice cream etc., cd covers, other plastic items such as buckets and toys. Plastic bags and plastic wrap.

Containers must be empty and rinsed.



→ There are 1-2 containers for hard and soft plastic rubbish at each garbageshed in the backyard

METAL

Recycled in new products.

Metal is eg beverage containers of metal without deposit/return system, clean tins and cans, pots and pans, utensils and

foil, nails and screws, tools and metal boxes.

Food containers must be empty. Place large items separately.



→ There is one container for metal related rubbish at each garbageshed in the backyard

BIO WASTE

Converted into biogas and fertiliser. Bio waste is all food waste raw as well as cooked, meat, fish, bones, fruits, vegetables, eggs, eggshells, nuts, rice, breakfast

products, coffee grounds, coffee filters, tea leaves, used kitchen towels and cut flowers. *Use only biodegradable wastebags and always tie the knot on.*



→ There is one container for bio waste at each garbageshed in the backyard
