HOW WE WORK:

FIVE STEPS TO YOUR COMPLETED PROJECT:

To try and make things straightforward we have broken our service down in to five simple steps. Our fee will be apportioned to each of these steps and although we always recommend a full architectural service any of the steps can stand on their own.

This approach gives our clients a clear understanding of what they can expect at each stage and helps us develop a tailored service to suit any project.

I SKETCH DESIGN & FEASIBILITY

At this stage we will carry out investigations to determine whether or not your project is feasible. This may involve meeting with the local planning department, carrying out site analysis and developing your brief.

We will also begin the concept design stage producing sketch proposals for discussion that will be developed into a final design in step 2.



2 PLANNING APPLICATION

We will guide your project through the planning process: finalising the layout and appearance of the building; coordinating with any external consultants required; and organising all the information required for the submission of a planning application.

The design will now have been developed in significant detail but will need to be taken further in step 3 if Building Regulations approval is required.



3 BUILDING REGULATIONS

Our technical expertise allows us to provide the necessary information required for Building Regulations approval to be granted. We can advise on the best construction methods for performance and cost efficiency.


At this stage a competent and trusted builder could take the project on but to maintain control of cost and quality another level of detail is necessary.



4 DETAILED DESIGN

We will develop the design to sufficient detail to obtain competitive quotes from reliable local contractors. Obtaining a fixed price at this stage allows us to help you maintain full control of the cost, quality and deadline for your project.

The detail that is developed at this stage can make the difference between a good building and a great building.



5 CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION

Finally the last step of our service is to act as contract administrator for your project. We will prepare a contract between you and your builder, this will mean the builder has committed to a fixed price and completion date.

During the construction stage we manage the relationship with the builder: ensuring quality and taking the weight of the worries off your shoulders.



SUSTAINABILITY:
