Dear friends and colleagues,

Until now, we have had monthly INCEPT meetings for all who may have an interest. These meetings have been of great value for all of us, but they will be changed a bit.

The meetings will be network meetings every third month with general information and discussion, bringing new ideas to the table, and raise questions regarding practical issues or considerations, now that we are close to include the first patient, which will be in the end of April.

In addition, we will have platform management committee meetings every third month.

Because the work with international initiation has started, there are groups working on the development of new domains, and there may be a lot of questions in relation to trial initiation and implementation, that will need to be discussed and decided in this forum.

The members of the platform management committee will receive invites via e-mail as well. The first platform management committee meeting will be 23 April, 15:00 to 16:00 (CET).

Updates

Stakeholder Involvement:

The first step in developing the core outcome measurement set (COMS) is to define the concept behind each core outcome. We have appointed Outcome Committees to work on this task and plan to involve the Research Panels (with patients, family, clinicians, and researchers) in these discussions at a preliminary stage during the spring.

Currently, all 14 countries are participating in the core team/steering committee responsible for developing the COMS.

Methods:

- The key protocol documents (core protocol, Albumin domain-specific appendix, Danish national appendix) are available on the INCEPT [website](#) and may be freely shared.
- A protocol manuscript describing the overall design of INCEPT has been published in Acta Anaesthesiologica Scandinavica ([open access here](#)) This is the 'official' INCEPT reference going forward.

Data:

Overall, the development of the eCRF is progressing as planned.



Clinical domains

Albumin domain:

The team at RH are preparing the start-up in April and expect to rollout to a few more DK sites before the summer holiday and more after.

The national investigators will be contacted about the process (e.g., recruitment of sites, collecting site suitability forms and CVs, translation of participant documents, and CTA/data-agreements).

Thrombophylaxis domain:

Dr. Ruben Eck from Groningen, Netherlands, is currently visiting the Department here in Copenhagen, marking the beginning of a 3 months collaborative stay.

He, along colleague Dr. Erik Keus, are working with us to get the Thrombophylaxis domain up and running as the second INCEPT domain.

The Thrombophylaxis domain initiation is planned for Aug./Sep. 2025.
