There was broad agreement that we have come far and that it's likely that INCEPT in a few years will be what we had hoped for – our common trial platform, on which we assess many different interventions with broad engagement from academics, clinicians, and patients.

Alpha testing on our development server is underway and access is being granted to ever more people for testing workflows and bug hunting. The production server is being set up.

Funding applications are being prepared for the INCEPT-AF domain to be submitted in May and June.

Clinical domains

Albumin domain:

The Albumin domain will hopefully commence in late May at Rigshospitalet. We've been slightly delayed because our eCRF system, EasyRF, is not fully developed. The data group works very hard, and the prospects are very encouraging.

We hope to start three more DK sites before the summer holiday. That way, we'll learn a lot over summer to be ready starting many more sites from August and onwards.



Thrombophylaxis domain:

- The thromboprophylaxis survey has finally been published (<https://doi.org/10.1111/aas.70009>).
- The INCEPT-THROMBOPROPHYLAXIS domain protocol is approaching completion and we expect to distribute this to a wider group for feedback in the coming weeks.

Continuous glucose monitoring domain:

Blood Glucose Management in Adult Intensive Care Unit Patients (GEM-ICU) survey is currently being distributed and will remain open until the end of May.
