

Preliminary Online InFo-TED Academy 2021 Programme

March – June 2021

Three one-hour thematic webinars (March-May 2021)

These will be webinar sessions organized by InFo-TED that will be open to all and introduce thematic conversation around teacher educator professional development needs. For those who have secured a place on the InFo-TED Academy 2021, there is an expectation that they attend all three webinars. There will be some preparatory work before each webinar and related engagement after each webinar.

Session 1: Conceptualizing teacher educators professional development (March 2021)

Session 2: The professional development of higher-education based and school-based teacher educators (April 2021)

Session 3: The professional identity of teacher educators in a diversifying context (May 2021)

Each webinar will be followed by a 40-minute debrief open only to those who have secured a place on the InFo-TED Academy 2021.

Three half-day sessions for InFo-TED Academy 2021 participants (23-25 June 2021)

The three thematic webinars will be followed by three compulsory half day sessions. These half-day sessions will be open only to InFo-TED Academy 2021 participants and will follow-on from the three thematic webinars. The half-day sessions will be predominantly interactive with participants being encouraged to consider their own, and those who they are attending the Academy with, professional learning needs as teacher educators.
