Mosscrepe Fabric Material

The mosscrepe type of robe, hijab & scarf is one of the derivatives of crepe fabric.

Although it feels like there is sand when touched, mosscrepe is a cool and smooth robe material. The feeling like there is sand is actually a characteristic of the fiber of the fabric. In addition, mosscrepe tends to be thick, not see through, and fall off.

With these characteristics, moscrepe is more often used to make modern syar'i clothing such as khimar.



2. Wollycrepe Fabric Material

Although it is still a crepe family with mosscrepe fabric, wollycrepe material has its own characteristics. Among the family of crepes with an orange peel texture, wollycrepes tend to be the smoothest and not too thick. Almost similar to wolfis, only the texture of wollycrepe is more pronounced.

Although wollycrepe is not very good at absorbing sweat, it is quite cool and doesn't make you hot. The nature of the fabric that falls down is also ideal for making hijabs & scarves because it is able to cover the head well.





3. Diamond Fabric Material

Similar to crepe fabric which has a texture like orange peel and if you touch it like there are grains of sand, diamond fabric also has almost the same characteristics. Compared to other types of crepe, diamond fabric is rougher and stiffer even though it still displays a smooth image and feels falling.

Another characteristic of diamond fabric is that it is thin and easily blown by the wind, but not transparent. Although sometimes used for robes, diamond fabrics which tend to be stiff and thin are more suitable for use as hijabs & scarves because they are easy to shape.



4. Balotelli Fabric Material

Balotelli fabrics are among the most easily recognizable types. The hallmark of this material is the texture of the small squares formed by the lines of the fabric fibers.

Balotelli material is not pure cotton, and this can be seen from the luster of the fabric which is not found in natural fabrics. Although it is thick and does not absorb sweat, balotelli is a cool material for robes, hijabs & scarves when worn. In addition to robes, balotelli are also often used to make skirts as well as hijabs and scarves.



5. Rayon Fabric Bahan

The fabric material from natural cotton fibers is no doubt because it can provide a cool and comfortable feeling when worn. Rayon material tends to be thin, which can be seen in cool and soothing Balinese blankets.

If usually bali blankets are more transparent, rayon is still not the case. Even though it is thin, the high quality makes it non-transparent so that it is smoother, falls, and makes it cool. Rayon in general is often used to make T-shirts, although it is also commonly found in the form of hijabs and Muslim clothing.





6. Wolfis Fabric

Wolfis material is indeed popular because of its low price and good quality. Wolfis or woolpeach is a fabric made of polyester, not fleece. Wolfis fabric has no special characteristics so it is not much different from fabrics in general.

Wolfis fabric has a smooth, thin, and not see-through texture. But because it is made of synthetic material, it will usually feel stifling. But in general, wolfis cloth is often used to make hijabs & scarves, svar'i clothes.



7. Maxmara Fabric Material

Maxmara fabric is not much different from satin, it even looks the same, it's just that the texture is smoother like silk. But compared to satin fabric, maxmara fabric is smoother, slicker, cool, and comfortable to wear. You will see a matte finish even though it is not conspicuous from this fabric.

The characteristics of this fabric are light and thin but not transparent. That is why, Maxmara is widely used to make women's dresses, tops, work clothes, and hijab materials.



8. Cigar Fabric Material

Cigar fabrics can be considered if you want to make a cool and comfortable robe. Has a special characteristic like chiffon but tends to be similar to orange peel which, if you look at it, will see wavy fibers like clouds or fog.

The texture is cool and seems to fall so that it will create a graceful and elegant impression when worn, also able to follow the curves of the wearer's body. Even though the cigar fabric is smooth and elastic, it doesn't stretch easily.



9. Toyobo Fabric Material

In addition to Inma Premium, Japan also exports Toyobo fabrics. The fibers of this fabric are very tight and not see through. The general characteristics are cool, smooth, easy to manage, and not slippery like maxmara.

Toyobo fabric absorbs sweat and does not make it hot, highly recommended as a hijab, outer, pashmina, blouse, and shirt material. These characteristics can make the wearer more elegant when wearing it.





10.Polycotton Material

This material is a mixture of polyester and cotton. The character of this polycotton hijab material is thin and you have to iron it neatly when you want to wear it.

Cotton hijab material is also the most sought after by hijabers in 2020 because it directly sticks to the face when worn. However, cotton material is easily wrinkled or wrinkled. You have to iron neatly, when you want to wear a cotton hijab. Premium cotton is usually easier to iron.

If you want to attend an invitation, shimmer cotton hijab material can be an option. The shimmer cotton hijab material is shiny and easy to shape.




Batik Fabric Aksata

Batik Fabric is a pictorial Indonesian cloth that is made specifically by writing or applying wax to the cloth, then processing it in a certain way that has its own characteristics. Batik is an Indonesian technique of wax-resist dyeing applied to the whole cloth, or cloth made using this technique. Of Javanese origin, batik is made either by drawing dots and lines of the resist with a spouted tool called a canting, or by printing the resist with a copper stamp called a cap. The applied wax resists dues and therefore allows the artisan to color selectively by soaking the cloth in one color, removing the wax with boiling water, and repeating if multiple colors are desired. A tradition of making batik is found in cultures such as Nigeria, China, India, Malaysia, Sri Lanka and most notably, Indonesia. Indonesian coastal batik made in the island of Java has a long history of acculturation, with diverse patterns influenced by a variety of cultures, and is the most developed in terms of pattern, technique, and the quality of workmanship. On October 2009, UNESCO designated Indonesian batik as a Masterpiece of Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity. In the same year, UNESCO was also recognized "Education and training in Indonesian Batik intangible cultural heritage for elementary, junior, senior, vocational school and polytechnic students, in collaboration with the Batik Museum in Pekalongan" as Masterpiece of Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity in Register of Good Safeguarding Practices List. Batik is considered a cultural icon in modern Indonesia, where "National Batik Day" is celebrated annually on October 2, and many Indonesians continue to wear batik on a daily basis for casual and formal occasions.
