



Junior VIPs Nursery Fees Structure: Parents/Carers

Deposit: £100 deposit required (payable by bank transfer). This is refundable in accordance with our contract.

Registration Fee: A non-refundable administration fee of £50 is payable on enrolment.

Our fees include extra-curricular activities, meals, snacks and milk (excluding formula milk, nappies and wipes).

We may increase our fees with one month's notice and will in any event review our fees every September, though not exclusively.

We request all children who are under 3 years old to have a minimum of 2 full day or 3 half day sessions to enable the children to settle well into the nursery and become used to the nursery routines.

Nursery Fees and Funding for children over 9 months old

30 hour Stretched funding – Stretched to 22 hours over 51 weeks

Children from working families may be entitled to 30 hours nursery education funding (NEF) for 38 weeks of the year. At Junior VIPs Nursery, we stretch this funding so you receive 22 hours over 51 weeks of the year. Parents also have to pay full fees for any additional hours and sessions.

The free entitlement also includes food and any extra-curricular activities during the funded sessions.



To find out if you are eligible for the 30 hours funding, please apply through the website www.childcarechoices.gov.uk. Please note that for you to claim the funding, you must have given us the HMRC code by 31 August to claim in September, by 31 December to claim in January or 31 March to claim in April. You will also need to renew the code every few months to ensure that it remains valid.

For those children with morning funded sessions only, the 22 hours would be split over 4 mornings between 7:30am-1:00pm. For those children with afternoon sessions only, the hours would be split over 4 afternoons between 1:00pm and 6:30pm. For those who wish to do full days, their morning sessions will be funded and afternoon sessions will be non-funded so their day will be between 7:30am and 6:00pm. There is a limit of 1 funded session per day, i.e., 7.30am to 1.00pm or 1.00pm to 6.30pm not both on the same day.

Nursery Fees for Children over 3 years' old – for non-working families

15 hours universal Stretched funding – stretched to 11 hours over 51 weeks

All children over 3 years old are entitled to a maximum of 15 hours of nursery education funding (NEF) for 38 weeks of the year. At Junior VIPs Nursery, we stretch this funding so you receive 11 hours over 51 weeks of the year. Parents also have to pay full fees for any additional hours and sessions.

The free entitlement also includes food and any extra curricular activities during the funded sessions.

For those children with morning funded sessions only, the 11 hours would be split over 2 mornings between 7:30am-1:00pm. For those children with afternoon sessions only, the hours would be split over 2 afternoons between 1:00pm and 6:30pm. For those who wish to do full days, their morning sessions will be funded and afternoon sessions will be non-funded so their day will be between 7:30am and 6:00pm. There is a limit of 1 funded session per day, i.e., 7.30am to 1.00pm or 1.00pm to 6.30pm not both on the same day.

When does your child become eligible for Nursery Education Funding?

Your child may be eligible for the nursery education funding fee rate for working parents from the term after your child turns 9 months old. They will be eligible for the universal 15 hour funding from the term after your child turns 3 years old. This means that if they reach the required age by:

31 March, they will be eligible from 1st April (Summer Term)

31 August, they will be eligible from 1st September (Autumn Term)

31 December, they will be eligible from 1st January (Spring Term)



These are official cut-off dates which are set by the local authority and national government.

Incorporating the Government Nursery Education Funding into the Monthly Fee:

The nursery education funding entitlement is for 51 weeks; however, our fees are calculated per calendar month. The invoice will detail what elements are eligible for the Nursery Education Funding and will ensure each family still receives their correct 51 week entitlement.

We can discuss your individual fee structure during the registration and enrolment process.

Fee Payment

Fees are to be paid in advance on or before the 1st day of every month; this covers the monthly child care fees.

Please note that full fees are due and must be paid on the following occasions:

- Child's holiday
- Child's sickness
- Any other reason for absenteeism.
- When nursery is closed (Bank Holidays and the week between Christmas and New Year)

Notice Period

You are required to give one month's notice in writing stating that you no longer require a place at the nursery. Fees must be paid up until the end of the notice period.
