Another year is just getting over and it is time to meet and look at what KKS EC team could do for its members. I feel this year was the most happening year from the perspective of our contribution to the society. KKS launched KKS Sudha Nidhi scholarship program as part of Beti Padaho, Beti Bachhao mission and sponsored the course fee of Rs. 25000/- for 7 girls to undergo training on Tally software for six months so as to make them employment ready, organized by VIDYA, NGO empowering girls of weaker section of the society. Ms. Ritu Karidhal Srivastava, an eminent space scientist at ISRO Bangalore and one of our esteemed members donated Rs. 6 lakhs to KKS for empowering underprivileged girls. KKS is thankful to Ms. Ritu and her family for this gesture. Five out of 7 Girls who got trained by VIDYA got employed and are now living life gracefully.

Digital transformation is what we have started witnessing all across and it is the way we would be driving practically everything moving forward. Considering the rich history of KKS and the large amount of data what we have in the form of paper records, it was decided to digitize it starting from the inception of KKS and upload the same on Google drive so as to allow members to access desired information like MoMs, Newsletters, Event Photos. MISSION DOCUMENT DIGITIZATION - KKS

NK Shrivastava & RS Bahadur

In view of keeping in pace with the developments taking place in the field of Information Technology, a need was felt to go digital for the stored information of Karnataka Kayastha Sabha since its inception. This idea was mooted in one of the KKS Executive Committee meetings and overwhelmingly accepted. A task force was created comprising of N.K Shrivastava, Mayank Srivastava, Animesh Bisaria, R S Bahadur, Rajeev Saxena and Mrs. Jyoti Khare. Mr. N K Shrivastava for his vast experience in data management accepted the request to lead the task force on KKS Document Digitization.

Since then all the available documents and records of last **36 years** (from 1981) were collected, classified, collated, digitized and uploaded on KKS Google Drive. They are archived under various categories like News Letters, Minutes of the EC Meetings, AGM reports, Members database, event photographs and other relevant documents for perpetual reference. To add to the protection of data on internet a backup was created by storing all the information in a portable and dedicated USB hard disk. The financial expenditure incurred for Data Digitization was shared by the present KKS EC members.

A lot of hard work and efforts went into it to realize this herculean task. The members of the task force took it in mission mode and completed in about four months. The team work was evident from the zeal with which the work was taken, propagated and completed. EC members of past and present were requested to share the details available at their end, data started pouring in all forms (hard copies and soft copies). Contribution towards document sharing from Col. Rahul Kumar (Retd.), Sri Shambhu Nath Varma, Sri Amar Jamadhiar. Sri Animesh Bisaria, Sri Sharad Mathur, Smt. Jyoti Khare and Sri NK Shrivastava are worth mentioning. Great efforts were put-in to digitize the hard copies of records by Sri Mayank Srivastava and Sri Rajeev Saxena. The document collation, classification and uploading were done by Sri N. K Shrivastava and R S Bahadur. The efforts by individuals made this as collective success and needs special appreciation.

KKS SUDHA NIDHI SCHOLARSHIP

KKS launched Sudha Nidhi scholarship under **Beti Padaho, Beti Bachhao mission** in 2017 and joined hands with **VIDYA, an NGO**.

A brief report by the program director, VIDYA.

An acronym for Vidya Integrated Development for Youth and Adults with its remarkable journey of **33 years** is a registered not-for-profit organization for the education and empowerment of less privileged children, youth and women through micro-level intervention. VIDYA is a movement of social change that focuses on seeing every under-privileged child get a sound education, every youth achieve his/her dream, and every woman be empowered to be an equal citizen.

VIDYA was founded in 1985 by **Rashmi Misra**, who taught a class of five girls in her home on the campus of IIT Delhi. Now, VIDYA works out of 60 projects based in five states of India; Delhi, NCR, Mumbai, Bangalore and Pune and has educated 3.5 Lakhs children, youth and women.

Vision: “To be a significant force of change for India’s less privileged.”

Mission: To educate and empower the less privileged through integrated methods and to initiate and implement progressive social change.

Program Overview

Tally basics and GST using Tally ERP9 program started at VIDYA Mali Foundation & VIDYA South Bangalore Centre in November 2017 with the scholarship support extended by Karnataka Kayastha Sabha for 7 women from local community, under its women empowerment programme.

Project Aim: The program aimed at providing young women with working and functional knowledge of NIIT certified Tally basics and GST. The demand for this skill is very high in today’s job market. The course has equipped them with the latest skill needed by job recruiters; this skill in addition to their general computer knowledge, gives them better pay scale and job opportunities.

Status update:

Shwetha and Priyanka have got jobs at Multibhashi with a starting salary of Rs.10,000/-, and Suma in Dominos as cashier on a take home salary of Rs.11300/-. Priya is getting married and thereafter, will look for a job. Kavyanjali has joined B. Com and hence wants to opt for a part time job to support her education. Two girls have yet to finish their exams.





AN APPEAL

KKS has been running on funds received in the form of sponsorships from both members and non-members, interest from bank on deposits and registration charges for the events being organized by its EC members.

Best possible efforts are always made not to spend money from its corpus which has grown to a reasonable size in the recent past and quarterly events are managed from the funds and sponsorships received during the events. Of late, due to relatively poor attendance in events, KKS has started facing crunch in terms of available funds, inspite of getting a good number of sponsorships both in cash and kind from its EC members.

It is worth mentioning that EC members contributed more than a lac in cash and fifty thousand in kind this year alone in order to meet out the expenses on EC meetings and various events conducted so far. 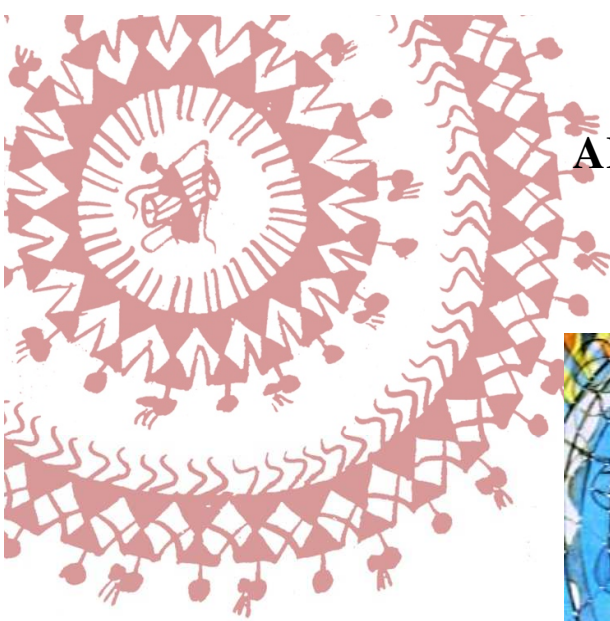

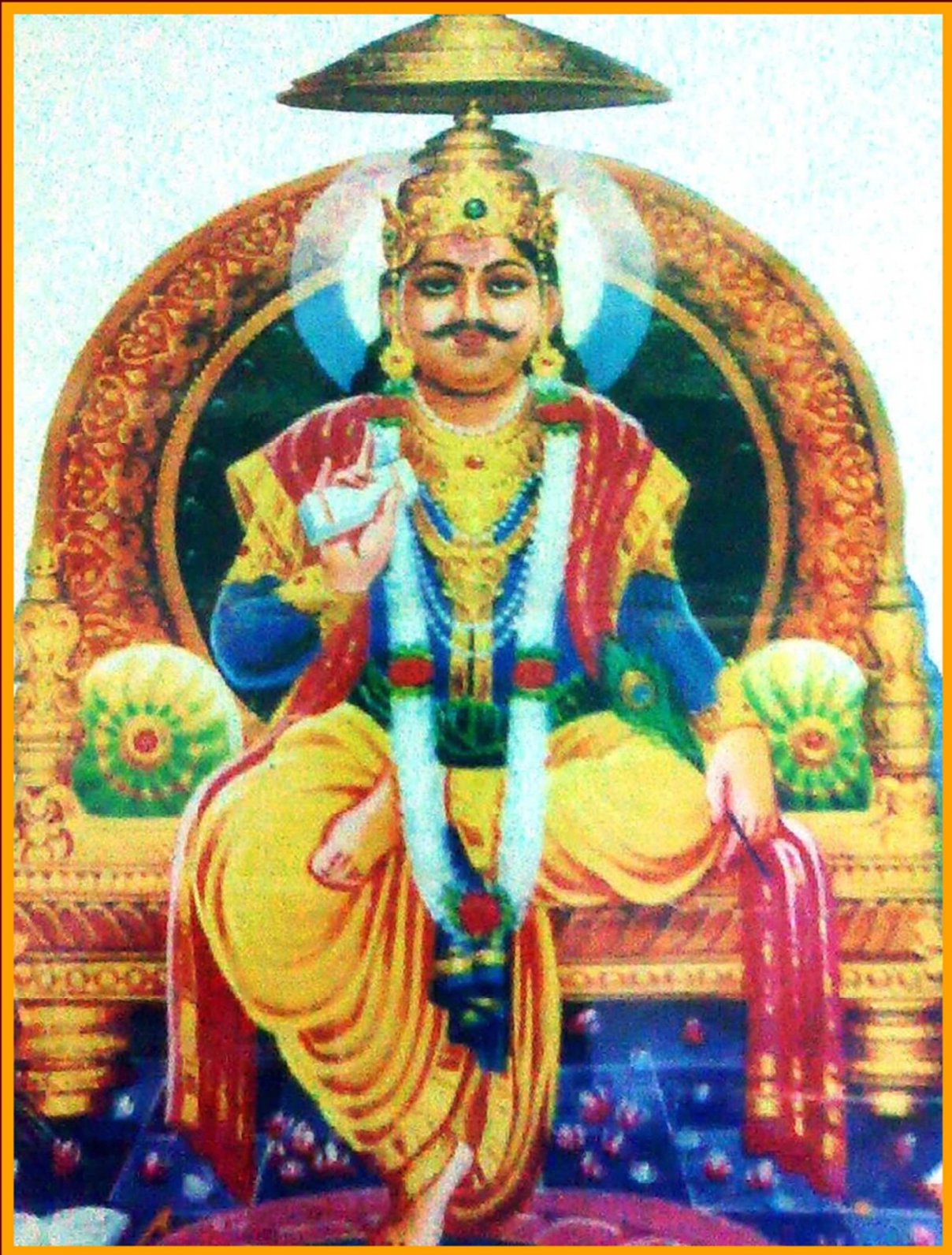
