

806 EXEMPTION FROM THE INCOME TAX DEPARTMENT A prestigious milestone

KKS achieved a major milestone for the first time in its history, by getting the IT exemption certificate under section 80G and 12AA of the Income Tax Act 1961 on 6th March 2021, against its applications dated 16/12/2019 (Form 10A) dated 17/12/2019 (Form 10G). **DIN & Order Nos.** – ITBA/EXM/S/80G/2020-21/1031286879(1) dated 06/03/2021 and ITBA/EXM/S/12AA/2020-21/1030929996(1) dated 24/02/2021.

KKS is now free from tax liability and its members who donate for its objectives, are entitled to get a 50% exemption under section 80G while filling their tax returns, as per the provisions mentioned in the above certificates/letters/orders. The exemption is valid from the assessment year 2020-21 till it is rescinded. Team EC needs to maintain its documents and transactions as per the guidelines of the Registrar of Society (RoS) and Income Tax (IT) in this regard meticulously on a regular basis, as non-compliance could result in the cancellation of the above certificates/exemption.

As per new guidelines of the IT department, team EC submitted the revised FORM 10A and 80G with desired information on 22nd Feb 2022 online onto the portal of the IT department, in consultation with its Senior Advisor Mr. R K Gupta. Team EC added the following categories (Sr. no. 2 to 6) in order to enhance the objectives to be considered for issuing the revised exemption certificate.

- 1. Relief to the poor
- 2. Education
- 3. Medical Relief
- 4. Preservation of the Environment (Including watersheds, forests, and wildlife)
- 5. Preservation of Monuments or Places or Objects of Artistic or Historic interest
- 6. Advancement of any other objects of general public utility

We are pleased to inform you that KKS received the Order for approval granted under provision 11-Clause (I) of the first provision to sub-section (5) of section 80G of Income Tax Act 1961 with **Unique Registration Number for 80G - AAGAK4139DF20214 and for 12A - AAGAK4139DE20216 dated 10/03/2022 from AY 2022-23 to AY 2026- 2027**. Thanks to our senior advisor Mr. R K Gupta for his timely support and guidance.

SCULPTING THE ABSTRACT

Mind is an abstraction, emerging from the brain. The brain is defined into Id, Ego and Superego. According to Sigmund Freud, the Id is a component of an individual's personality that is entirely unconscious and involuntary. It includes the very basic, instinctive behaviour of an individual. The Id is also driven by the 'pleasure principle' which requires immediate appeasement or gratification of basic needs like hunger and thirst. Freud reiterates that the Ego develops from the Id and ensures that these basic or primitive instincts of man are presented to society in a much more palatable manner, within acceptable societal norms. The Ego hence operates on the 'reality principle' which endeavours to fulfil the Id's longings as per permissible social fabric and thus uses the theory of 'delayed gratification'. Finally, of primordial importance is the Super-ego which reflects the internalised moral standards already acquired from parents who are a part of the social fabric. Hence the Super Ego civilizes our responses to society. The proper balance between these three parts of the psycho-analytical structure of the brain, as suggested by Freud is of utmost necessity, as this leads to an adaptive personality. These three parts are dynamic and work in tandem with each other for greater efficiency and limberness in accommodating and adapting to societal nuances.

The Id thus catches the shimmering thoughts and images from the depths of the mind, Ego gives these images a pattern and the Super-ego gives these patterns a definitive construct.

Let us now deliberate upon these aspects differently. The normal ingredients of the mind are:

- 1. An ability to think and,
- 2. an awareness of the surroundings.

It also incorporates the ability to analyse and comprehend unity in diversity, thus paving the way for discernment and appreciation of beauty.

Mind also inculcates unto itself a sense of wisdom. Wisdom includes religiosity and an ethical sense of good and bad or a deep perception of righteousness.

In single acts of nature though, animals are superior to human beings. In social organisations, migratory birds seem to be deft and impeccable. They have an incredible record of landing at a particular place in a particular season according to their adaptability to the prevalent climatic conditions. Ants also depict skilled organisational abilities as they follow a straight line in pursuit of gratification of their needs. This is indicative of their adherence to social order and mannerisms.

On the other hand, monkeys seem to hug their dead babies till they turned skeletons; so in love for their offspring, some of the animals seem to obliterate the scientific foundation of reason or rationality but remain drenched with layers and layers of love, affection, camaraderie and communion. Despite such seething emotional, base and also sometimes rational behaviour of the animals, they are far inferior to human beings in acts of the mind.

When an infant rolls up in this world, his mind is 'Tabula Rasa' – a clean slate that is ready to be written on. Education is the orchestration of different paradigms of the mind and a complete, metrical synthesis of the three components of the mind – ID, Ego, and Super-ego. Hence aptly put by Sigmund Freud:

"The poor Ego has a still harder time of it; it has to serve three harsh masters, and it has to do its best to reconcile the claims and demands of all three...... The three tyrants are the external world, the super-ego, and the Id"

From the book - Analysis 1933.

Today we stand at the crossroads of the social fabric, where because of unrelenting information percolation, we are gradually moving towards the degradation of mental abilities. As TS Eliot says "Where is wisdom, we have lost in knowledge, where is knowledge, we have lost in information." A slight chiseling of the mind is mandatory for proper education. Education today relies more on rote learning and mindless competition, which has stolen the sheen out of the rational educational approach.

History is replete with examples of inventions that were created out of the sheer passion of individuals who wanted to alter the course of humanity, rather than the personal desire to excel amidst their peers.

A well-balanced learning hinges upon a quest for excellence through inquisitiveness, connecting the dots or pieces of information and repositioning them to create a knowledge base that relies not only on satiating one's personal aspirations but also can be used for the greater good of society. Such a quest for knowledge not only stokes the ID, but also balances the Ego and the Super-ego, in harmony with the wisdom of mankind over any of the basal instincts.

ARCHITECT G P MATHUR GETS LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD



TWO STAR PLAYERS OF INDIAN CRICKET BECOME UMPIRES



A PEN PORTRAIT

Kali Kumar Sinha was the worthy son of a distinguished father who was no less a person than Hon'ble Rai Bahadur Gajadhar Prasad, Member, Bengal Legislative Council, President, All India Kayastha Conference (1892), President, All India Kayastha Sadar Sabha (for 17 years), and one of the best cross-examiners that Bihar has ever seen. Gajadhar Prasad was a lawyer of great eminence and he was helpful in establishing Patna Law College along with other eminent lawyers of Patna such as Govind Chandra Mishra, Radha Kesto Bhattacharya, and some others.

Kali Kumar Sinha, as the past whispers, was a professor at Patna Law College in the second decade of the twentieth century. In the beginning, he was the sole in charge of leadership classes; thereafter he was drafted into the Law College, when the College was in its infancy, learning to toddle during the regime of Babu Atma Ram.

Sinha was also one of the pioneer journalists in Bihar having started two dailies, 'The Bihar Guardian' and 'The Biharee'. Having embarked upon a journalistic career, he bestrode the province of Bihar like a colossus. He opposed the partition of Bengal both as a lawyer and as a journalist. The partition of Bengal would issue in fissiparous tendencies, culminating in an alignment of centrifugal forces in the country. With the advantage of hindsight now, his seems to be a reasoned as well as a more mature vision. But neither Law nor journalism could contain his spirit and he cut across their frontiers and tried his hand at penmanship. Here he found the fruition of his vision. He was a born genius, and a novel, *The Star of Sikri* (1893) flowed from his facile pen while he was a 3rd year student.

The book evoked the admiration of Professor James of Patna College. G.P. Sarma comments on *The Star of Sikri* as 'the first Indo-Anglian social novel with a reformative purpose'. In this novel, Sinha writes about the social evils arising out of unwilling marriages. The story is about a beautiful girl Rajani Kumari of Sikri, a village town in Bihar, who is given away in marriage when she is only eleven. But Gopal Kishen, the bridegroom, is not her choice. So, the girl refuses to consent to her Gauna (final marriage after the attainment of puberty). G.P. Sarma remarks: 'The author intends to show through this how the father's approach to the problem was wrong, and how this wrong approach of the parents in the Hindu Society to the marriages of their sons and daughters invites trouble'. Sinha explicitly expresses his disapproval of such parental notions. He says: 'The girl is yoked to a rich man, without any consideration of her feelings towards him'.

G.P. Sarma claims to have brought to light Sanjogita for the first time in his book on 'Nationalism in Indo-Anglian Fiction.

Sanjogita is based on the familiar story of Sanjogita, the daughter of King Jey Chand. In the preface, the author discloses his objectives. While writing the preface in the third person, Sinha says: 'The author has made an attempt to describe... the India of the Pre-Mohammedan period—India on the eve of the Mohammedan conquest, to remind his countrymen of the glory and greatness of their ancestors, to draw their attention to the direct causes of their fall, to show up the glaring evils of disunion'. After a perusal of the novel, it can be asserted that there are two concerns that emerge powerfully. (i) Quest of the past heritage (ii) championing the cause of freedom. The pride in the past has a tinge of national self-assertion. Both concerns seem interwoven. It is a search for identity, a reassertion of one's being in the context of one's nation. It is an individual's rebellion against the claustrophobic sense of slavery and an endeavour at opening up new vistas of freedom.

In the novel, the author's urge for unity between Hindus and Muslims is his prescription for fighting a united battle for freedom. G.P. Sarnia refers to the same in a similar vein, pointing to what Sinha writes in the preface: "His expression of respect for 'the dead ashes of the Hindu warriors and the calcined bones of Mohammedan soldiers' in the same breath, and his lamentation for the degradation of the spiritual sons of Aryavarta and the remarkable fall of the devoted followers of the godly prophet of Arabia' in the same breath again, show clearly how to the author in 1903, both the Hindus and the Muslims of India were equally Indian Nationals and formed one Nation." Sinha locates the novel on the eve of the Mohammedan conquest of India with a view to showing the faults of the Indians because of which the foreigners could continue invading India. A similar situation had obtained when the Britishers penetrated into India. In fact, the author intended to rouse the Indians to fight a battle against the British and free India from foreign yoke. In Sanjogita ' we see the handling of History for the nationalistic purpose for the first time in the history of Indo-Anglian fiction. But this was not all. He was the author of several books including one on Hindu Law and was a fine gifted orator in English, which he had inherited from his father, and which he passed on to his son, B.K. Sinha, Principal of Patna Law College and Chotanagpur Law College and Treasurer and Acting Vice-Chancellor of Bhagalpur University. B.K. Sinha's forte was humor. His was a very pleasing personality, always immaculately dressed, injuring the arrogant with his ready wit and sharp witticism but endearing himself amicably well with the high and the low in equal measure. In the American Express, a daily newspaper published in England, an exclusive article was published on him captioned The Charlie Chaplin of India. His death in 1978 brought in a void or a vacuum in the cultural life of Bihar He was a fine orator, a humorist, a connoisseur par excellence.

Revisit Karnataka tourism policy

A WARMA

armataka boasts abundant natural resources, UNESCO world heritage sites, and remarkable architectural marvels. It is rewered as the 'Cradle of Stone Architecture'. With its pleasant climate, welcoming locals, authentic cuisine, accessibility and connectivity, rich culture, and spirit of camaraderie, Karnataka has all the elements to be a must-visit destination in the subcontinent. Moreover, it has already established Bengaluru's reputation as the IT capital of India.

Presently, the state's share indomestic tourism is just 12%, behind Tamil Nadu (17.02%), Uttar Pradesh (16.19%), and Andhra Pradesh (18.27%). Tourism is a significant GDP driver (around 8%). In 2019, Karnataka's tourism sector contributed 4.8% of the state's gross state domestic product (GSDP) and provided over 30 lakh jobs. This compares well with the overall figure for India (around 6.2%).

(around 6.2%).

While southern Karnataka is a well-known tourist hub, the northern Karnataka districts—Dharwad, Belgaum, Vijayapura, Bagalkot, Uttar Kannada, Haveri, Kalburgi, and Bidar—also have potential for development. The state has seen improvements in its infrastructure, road networks, healtheare, educational institutions, etc. With the opening of the T2 terminal in Bengaluru, the new airport in Kalburgi, and the upgrades of Mysuru, Hubbali, and Belagavi airports, theaccessibility of the region has increased manifod. Similarly, the proposed airports in Shivamogga and Vijapura wouldfurther open Karnataka. Coorg and Chikmagluru have already emerged as new hill destinations, drawing boards of visitors from all lover India.

Belgaum is situated on the periphery of the Western Ghats, surrounded by shrub jungles, grasslands, and forests. Dharwad is uniquely situated in the Eco-Tone Belt, which stretches from Belgaum to Rancbennur. Varied ecosystems like the Western Ghats forests, scrub-jungles, ponds, and grassland ecosystems merge into one another and form a unique geographical location comprising several districts of the North Karnataka. (The writer districts of the North Karnataka region. Vijapura and Bagalkot

are well known for historical monuments, and the region has heritage sites such as Aihole, Badami, Pattadkal, and Bijapur's Golgumbaz. The area also produces some of the best wines.

Uttar Kannada district is rich in several respects tropical, evergreen, and deciduous forests; ancient rivers like Aghanashini, Kali, Gangavali, and Sharavati; virgin beaches along the West Coast; and numerous historical and religious monuments, temples, and forts overlooking the rivers, beaches, forests, and wildlife. They are all areas waiting to be developed.

The Hampi beritage site and the evergreen forests of Uttar Kannada district are all within a reachable distance of a few hours from Hubballi, Dharwad, Belgaum, Goa, and Maharsahtra. Some of the best-known tiger reserves, wild life sanctuaries, national parks, and birdsanctuaries are situated in the above region, which is also known for whitewater rafting. In short, Karnataka must

in short, Karnataka must consider developing its districts with a special focus on tourism—eco, cultural, adventure, hospitality, health, wine, and study tourism.

and study tourism.

To increase the share of tourism in the state's economy, Karnataka must make policy changes to declare tourism an industry and develop infrastructure, including affordable travel and stay facilities, with the government and the private sector working together. The existing facilities ontourist circuits should be given a complete makeover. Developing roadside amenities in important destinations should be a priority.

The tourism sector, being a long-term investment proposition, would need the full participation of all stakeholders. An independent tourism development board should be established to chalk out a long-term strategy to attract visitors, both domestic and foreign. Standards and certification aspects must be brought into the system for visitor satisfaction as well as for ensuring quality of services and overall sustainability.

A new vision and new strategy are needed to realise the true potential of tourism in Karnataka.





- o No posts which have contents that are violent, pornographic, or discriminatory against any religion/community/Individual.

It has been observed that a few members unintentionally post or send non-Kayasthas forwards to KKS Members, resulting in the loss of important notifications and action items.

The KKS Admins will strictly monitor it and will exercise their right to delete, incase of infringements. These guidelines are important and need to be followed religiously by all members so as to ensure important information is not lost in the clutter.

Requesting members help us make KKS a processes-driven society to be different from other such societies.
