| | Agenda Points Discussed: Welcome by the President: At the outset, Mr. Animesh Bisaria, President, KKS greeted members who were present and extended a warm welcome to them for joining the AGM. He mentioned that the EC team made all possible efforts to organize the offline AGM on 11 th Sept 2022 which was later postponed to 18 th September 2022 due to uncertain weather conditions in and around Bangalore. Since the weather conditions didn't improve, the AGM was changed to online mode and rescheduled at 7.00 pm on 17 th Sept 2022 over the online Zoom platform, considering larger participation and convenience of members. The notification in this regard was sent to members over WhatsApp and also through mail dated 18 th August 2022 and then 13 th September 2022. President also applauded the efforts spent by Mr. Mayank Srivastava, Mr. A M Mathur, and Mrs. Deepa Srivastava towards organizing an offline AGM at Ferncity, Bangalore. The meeting started on time as scheduled but members who joined were requested to wait for half an hour to get the quorum completed and thereafter, the meeting started with available members. |

Presentation of Annual Report for FY 2021-22

President informed members that he had shared a very comprehensive Annual Report both in Doc and PPT formats well in advance multiple times over WhatsApp and through mail dated 13th September 2022 for the benefit of members, seeking their feedback in terms of corrections of the data presented in the report and also for further improvements.

The feedback received was incorporated and the final report was shared on 17th September 2022. Members applauded the efforts spent by the President and the team on a very comprehensive Annual Report (93 pages) which came out very well covering all the activities carried out throughout the FY 2021-22 and until 17th September 2022.

President presented the PPT report highlighting the important achievements like **registration renewal for FY 2021-22 from the Registrar of Society (RoS) and 80G and 12AA approvals from the Income Tax (IT) department for five years i.e., from AY 2022-23 to AY 2026-27** under six categories mainly

- Relief of the Poor
- Education
- Medical Relief
- Preservation of Environment (including watersheds, forests, and wildlife)
- Preservation of Monuments or Places or Objects of Artistic or Historic interest
- Advancement of any other objects of general public utility

The entire report was presented by sharing the screen with the members and explaining important points. Members appreciated the work done by the EC team and accepted the Annual Report for FY 2021-22 during the AGM unanimously.

Mr. Animesh Bisaria, the President also shared the feedback about KKS he received from other similar societies operating at various locations in India. He mentioned that KKS is gaining popularity across India, increasing members' expectations. Needless to say, the team EC needs to think big and deliver more moving forward.

He further mentioned that most of the activities during the FY 2021-22 were organized online due to restrictions imposed by the Government during the Corona pandemic. Further, he informed members that the proceedings of the AGM would be captured in audio and video formats. The same would also be shared with members to enable them to watch the same at leisure and keep them as records for future reference.

Approval for Minutes of the Meeting (MoM) of AGM for FY2020-21

President requested members to kindly recall that KKS had its last AGM for FY 2020-21 at 6.30 pm on 12th September 2021 over the online Zoom platform. The minutes of the meeting (MoM) along with AGM proceedings in the form of video recordings were shared with the members over WhatsApp groups of KKS and also through an email on 20th September 2021. Proposed Amendments and Resolutions in the Bylaws

The present members felt that the existing membership fee of Rs 2500/- for life and Rs. 1500/- for the short term are very reasonable and should be continued without any changes.

The below-mentioned members proposed and seconded, and all members present unanimously approved the same without any objections.

President informed members that an annual donation drive would be carried out from time to time for charitable activities in line with the objectives of KK Samaj.

President also mentioned that he is thinking of providing membership ID cards to all members. The idea was liked by all members and the same needs to be implemented shortly.

President briefed about the issues raised by a few members regarding the purpose and usage of WhatsApp groups mainly KKS EC, KKS Announcement, and KKS infotainment, and suggested appropriate guidelines to be implemented for effective communication amongst members.

This was also agreed upon and approved by all members who were present during the AGM. President was asked to share the guidelines ASAP.

Presentation of Financial Report by Treasurer

Appointment of Auditor and Consultants for Audit and Compliance Requirements

Mr. Lokesh K who has been providing services to KKS for the last couple of years agreed to do so for the FY 2022-23 at the same remuneration as last year as per his telephonic discussion with the President and subsequent proposal for the same for FY 2022-23 quoting Rs. 10000/- plus applicable taxes.

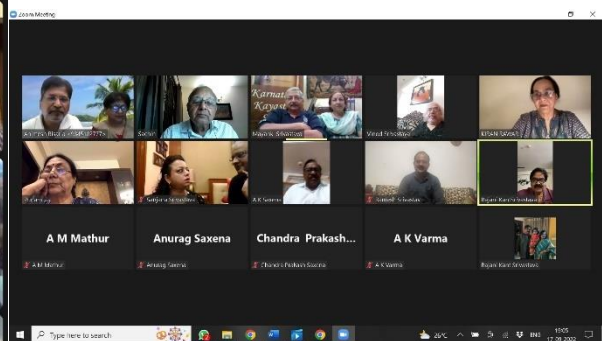
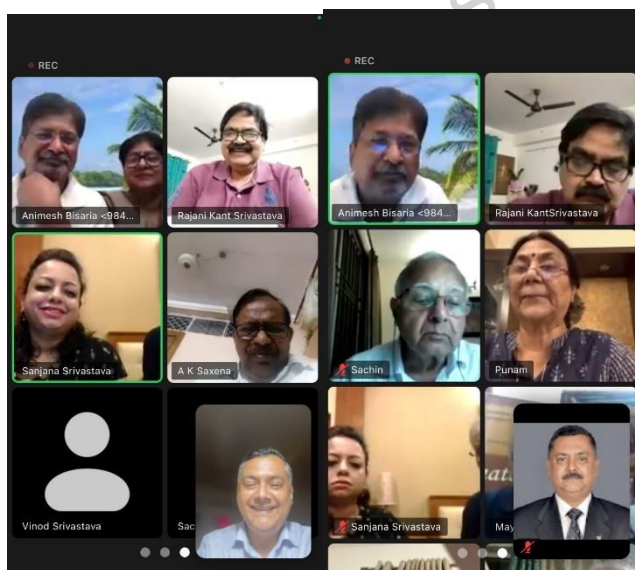
Vote of Thanks

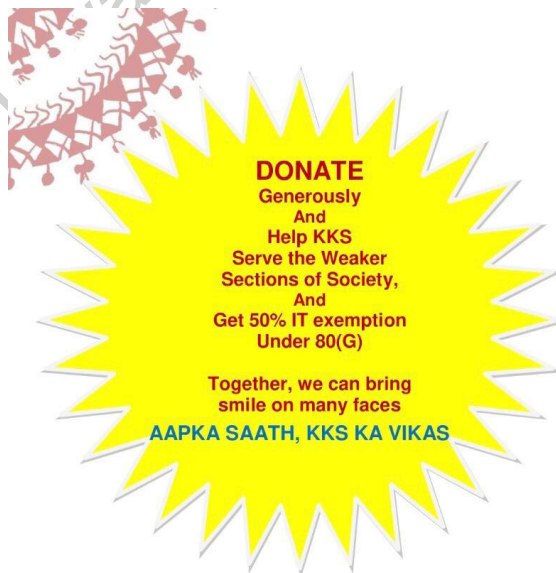
The team EC, therefore, made a humble appeal to members to donate generously to strengthen KKS and its smooth functioning and also to carry out charitable activities.
