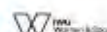

On behalf of the entire WAKO Board I'm very pleased of informing you that the bidding process for next WAKO Senior and Master World Championship 2021 for All Disciplines has been successfully completed.

We were very happy with the level of interest in hosting the event. We had very strong candidates and commend all of them for the effort and strength of the applications, in particular the strength of direct government support for all of the 4 proposals received, which was stronger in each application than in any other application of the past.

A member of the Organising Committee visited each proposed host city, hotels and arena during the last weeks and completed a survey for all the proposals. This report was reviewed by the WAKO Organising Committee and the review and its conclusions were presented by the Technical Director to the WAKO IF Board in occasion of the last Board meeting held on Saturday April 17th.

By the present we are notifying you that the Board of Directors of WAKO has finally approved the bid submitted by the Italian Federation (FEDERKOMBAT), so next **WAKO Senior and Master World Championship (All Disciplines)** will officially take place **from 14th to 24th October 2021 in Jesolo Lido (VE), in Italy**, at **PALAZZO DEL TURISMO (City sport Hall)**, which is same venue of the WAKO World Championship for Cadets and Juniors successfully held in 2018.

Knowing the experience of our Italian colleagues we are sure the event will be properly organized and the [WAKO Covid-19 Guidelines and Protocol](#) will be put in place to guarantee the safety of all the participants. As soon as the official invitation is ready containing all necessary details about the event it will be sent out and published on WAKO website.

We also would like to remind you that next WAKO Senior and Master World Championship will be the most prestigious event of this year being the official and only eliminator event for athletes eager to participate to **The World Games (for K-1 style)**, that will be held in **Birmingham (USA)**, from **7th to 17th July 2022**, and to the **World Combat Games in the disciplines of Point Fighting, Full Contact**, which are being held in **Asia in 2022**.

Moreover, please be informed of another important decision taken during the last WAKO Board Meeting: following a proposal from WAKO Europe and due to the rapid escalation of the Covid-19 pandemic in Hungary the Children, Cadets and Juniors European Championship that was supposed to be held in Gyor, in August, has been officially cancelled.

However, WAKO Europe alongside WAKO IF, is in the process to decide the new dates and location for a revised **European Championship 2021, with a reduced participation profile**, of which the European members will be promptly informed as soon as final decision will be ratified by the WAKO Europe Board of Directors. We expect this event to be finalized within two weeks. This will give our younger generation something to look forward to.

We will keep you informed of any other change of the WAKO Calendar, situations are different and changing every day in the countries but we keep on working positively in the best interest of our athletes.

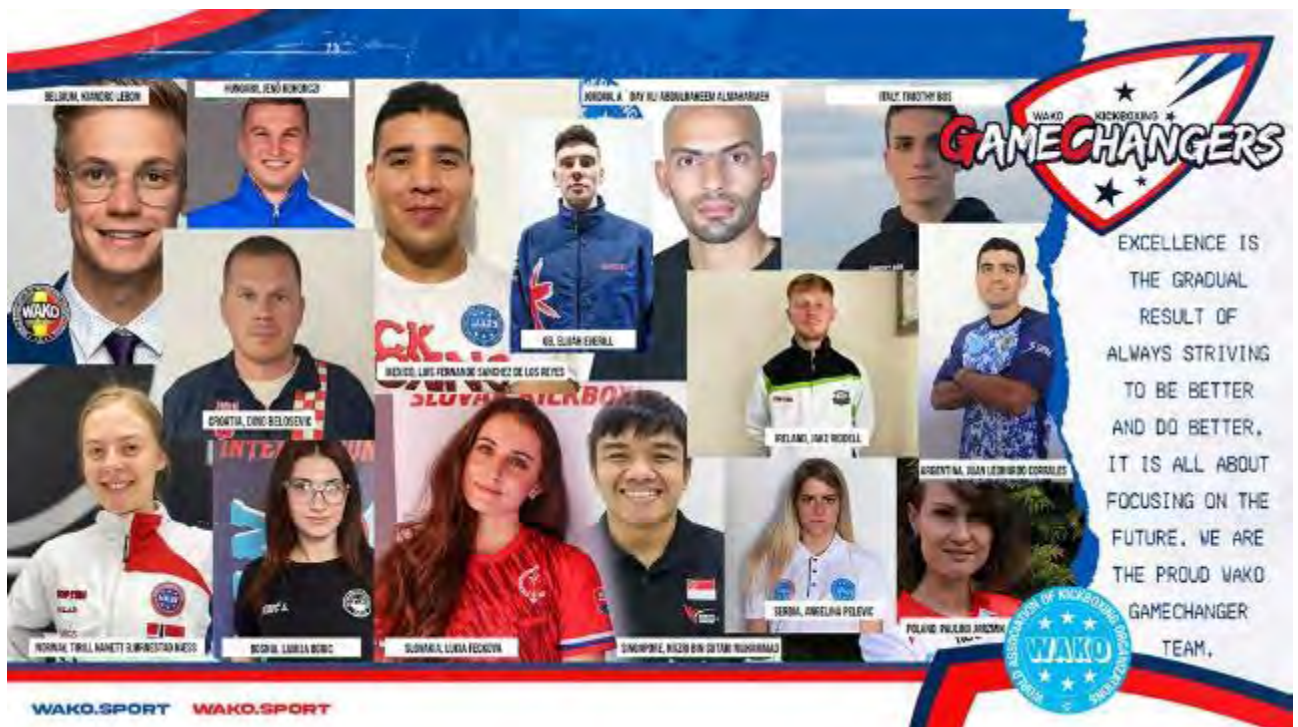

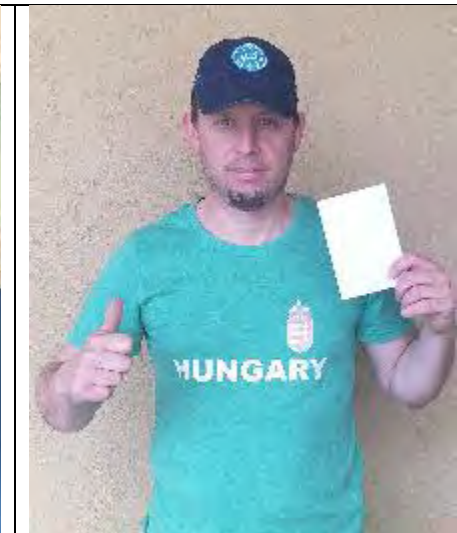

On behalf of the entire WAKO Board I'm very pleased of informing you that the bidding process for next WAKO Senior and Master World Championship 2021 for All Disciplines has been successfully completed. We were very happy with the level of interest in hosting the event. We had very strong candidates and commend all of them for the effort and strength of the applications, in particular the strength of direct government support for all of the 4 proposals received, which was stronger in each application than in any other application of the past.

A member of the Organising Committee visited each proposed host city, hotels and arena during the last weeks and completed a survey for all the proposals. This report was reviewed by the WAKO Organising Committee and the review and its conclusions were presented by the Technical Director to the WAKO IF Board in occasion of the last Board meeting held on Saturday April 17th.

By the present we are notifying you that the Board of Directors of WAKO has finally approved the bid submitted by the Italian Federation (FEDERKOMBAT), so next **WAKO Senior and Master World Championship (All Disciplines)** will officially take place **from 14th to 24th October 2021 in Jesolo Lido (VE), in Italy**, at **PALAZZO DEL TURISMO (City sport Hall)**, which is same venue of the WAKO World Championship for Cadets and Juniors successfully held in 2018.

Knowing the experience of our Italian colleagues we are sure the event will be properly organized and the WAKO Covid-19 Guidelines and Protocol will be put in place to guarantee the safety of all the participants. As soon as the official invitation is ready containing all necessary details about the event it will be sent out and published on WAKO website.


We also would like to remind you that next WAKO Senior and Master World Championship will be the most prestigious event of this year being the official and only eliminator event for athletes eager to participate to **The World Games** (for K-1 style), that will be held in **Birmingham (USA), from 7th to 17th July 2022**, and to the **World Combat Games in the disciplines of Point Fighting, Full Contact**, which are being held in **Asia in 2022**.

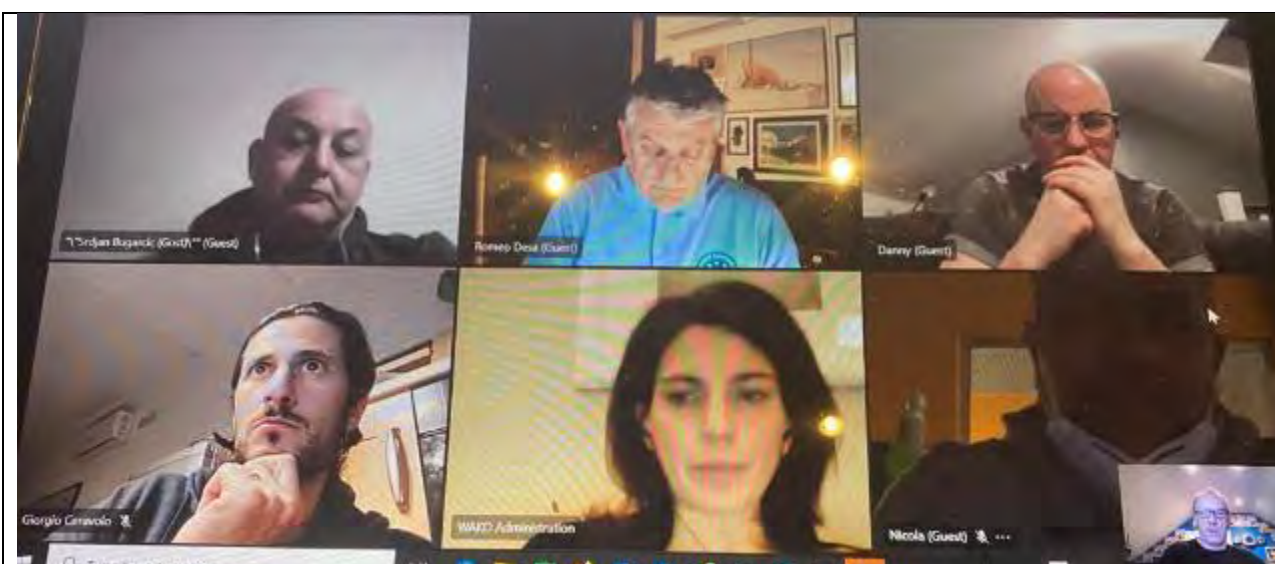

WAKO strategy and positioning inspired by the Olympic Agenda 2020+5 (DRAFT)

This document is created as a result of the new Olympic Agenda strategy called Olympic Agenda 2020+5. WAKO as a part of the Olympic Movement need to follow good practice and to constant focus on evolution and to extract relevant input from the Olympic Agenda. WAKO aim to be included in the Olympic Program and by living the same principles we can close the gap and to ensure the absolute best standards, for our members and for our athletes. Below a proposal of a realistic approach of WAKOs position for some of the 15 recommendations. Note that the below suggestions are created in a world affected by fragmentation amplified by the Covid-19 situation in 2020 and in 2021.

WADA releases "Sport-Values in Every Classroom" Toolkit now in French & Spanish

Montreal, 6 April 2021 – The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) announces the release of the "[Sport Values in Every Classroom](#)" toolkit in French and Spanish.

The toolkit – which was [first launched](#) in English in October 2019 during the Seventh UNESCO Conference of Parties (COP) relating to the International Convention against Doping in Sport – is a free, cross-curricular resource targeted at teachers of students aged 8-12 years old and aims to help teachers instill some of the core values synonymous with sport: respect, equity, and inclusion.

The toolkit was developed by six international organizations, collectively referred to as the "Education Partnership", namely: WADA; the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO); the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) (who replaced the Agitos Foundation); the International Council of Sport Science and Physical Education (ICSSPE); the International Fair Play Committee (IFPC); and the Olympic Foundation for Cultural Heritage (OFCH). The toolkit was based on commissioned research which was conducted by a team associated with the International Association for Physical Education in Higher Education (AIESEP).

This international collaboration highlights the importance of values-based education and the foundation it provides for ethical sporting behaviour – a common goal for the Education Partnership. The toolkit, which is free to access, can be used by teachers of any subject and by coaches or educators – anyone with a connection to young people – to help instill and reinforce the values of sport and the development of global citizenship.

WADA Director of Education, Amanda Hudson, said: "WADA is pleased to launch the French and Spanish versions of the 'Sport Values in Every Classroom' toolkit, in addition to the English version that is already available. Offering the toolkit in these key languages will allow the delivery of values-based education to an even wider global audience. Given its importance, values-based education is now a mandatory requirement within the International Standard for Education. This toolkit provides a solution for stakeholders to implement values-based education to a younger audience, setting an ethical foundation for the next generation of athletes.

"We strongly recommend that this toolkit is adopted by stakeholders. WADA, and the organizations of the Education Partnership, encourage individuals, academic and sports organizations, governments, anti-doping organizations and institutions responsible for teacher training to embed this toolkit into their education programs."

The toolkit consists of a set of 30 Activity Cards that act as complete lesson plans for educators of any subject and can be adapted to suit different contexts and populations. These activities can be delivered in the classroom, the gymnasium or outdoors, and can be used independent of, or to complement, an existing curriculum. The activities are engaging, fun, and movement-based, and have been successfully delivered to children both younger and older than the target age group. The toolkit also includes a Quick Guide and a Teacher's Companion, which provide academic support to those who seek extra guidance or ideas.

The toolkit can be downloaded in all three languages from any of the participating partners' websites. Stakeholders and/or educators wishing to translate the toolkit into another language are invited to contact any of the participating organizations to receive the Translation Guidance document, which was developed by all partners.

WADA releases Guidelines for effective testing and intelligence sharing

Dear Colleagues,

Today, the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) publishes the following two updated Guidelines to support Anti-Doping Organizations (ADOs) in their implementation of the 2021 [International Standard for Testing and Investigations \(ISTI\)](#), which came into force on 1 January 2021.

1. [Guidelines for Implementing an Effective Testing Program](#)
2. [Guidelines for Gathering Information and Sharing Intelligence](#)

These Guidelines are additional to the **Guidelines for Sample Collection Personnel** and **Guidelines for Sample Collection** that were published on [9 February 2021](#).

The four Guideline documents have been updated to align with the 2021 ISTI requirements; and also, to offer more practical examples for ADOs implementing effective testing and intelligence programs. While the four documents are currently available in English only, the French versions will follow in the coming weeks.

The Guidelines can be found on [WADA's website](#) and on the Agency's [Anti-Doping Education and Learning platform \(ADEL\)](#) as part of the [Code Implementation Support Program \(CISP\)](#). The Guidelines are accompanied by a number of [operational templates and checklists](#) for ADOs to use, which are also available on ADEL, including:

- Template: International Federation (and Major Event Organization) Risk Assessment & Test Distribution Plan (TDP)
- Template: National Anti-Doping Organization (NADO) Risk Assessment & TDP

- Template: RTP Inclusion Notice – Whereabouts to Other ADO
- Template: Testing Pool (TP) Inclusion Notice

- Template: Policy for Gathering Anti-Doping Intelligence
- Checklist: How to Comply with Article 11 of the ISTI (Intelligence)

In addition to the above templates and checklists, we encourage all stakeholders to visit ADEL for many other useful resources such as webinars, presentations, guides and more.

WADA Guidelines provide Code Signatories with recommended practices for several aspects of anti-doping programs. While they are not mandatory, they offer technical guidance to ADOs in the implementation of their anti-doping programs. As with all Guidelines under the World Anti-Doping Program, these documents are subject to ongoing review.

the importance of Antidoping Education has already been underlined in numerous Educational events throughout the last years. Education is a key part of our Antidoping program and strictly necessary in a logic of prevention of violations, as well as of integrity and fairness of our competitions and sport environment. Additionally, WAKO must comply with the standards and regulations mandated by the World Antidoping Agency and the International Olympic Committee.

The WAKO Antidoping Education Plan was presented and introduced in 2020 in a sequence of online events, and it is still present in WAKO Website. Its standards must be fulfilled by athletes but also other figures, like coaches, doctors and organizers, involved in the activity of your Federation.

For 2021, the Plan established a series of requirements, which are as follows:

All Senior Athletes competing in World and Continental Championships must have completed the "International-Level Athletes Education Program" prior to participation, upon creation of their own account on the WADA's ADEL platform:

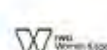

For event organizers: An Antidoping Education informative event (as an example, in form of a lecture, or a seminar, or a webinar), comprehensive of an **Informative desk**, must be organized and present at all World and Continental Championships. Organizers are advised to contact their National Antidoping Organization for assistance. Documentation about the event (such as photos) must be forwarded to the WAKO Medical, Health and Antidoping Committee.

The WAKO Medical, Health and Antidoping Committee will monitor and enforce compliance to the requirements described above. In particular, it is worth to mention that the WAKO Antidoping Officer has been granted the rights of “Power User” on the ADEL Platform and therefore he can monitor and visualize all the activity performed on the ADEL Learning Platform by every WAKO user. Therefore, controls will be performed on WAKO users accounts to verify completion of the relevant courses for every profile. In case of non-compliance with the standards of the Education Plan, sanctions will be imposed both on the athlete and on his/her National Federation (NFs). In particular, National Federations are required and expected to cooperate with WAKO IF in our Education Program, by providing assistance and guidance to athletes in completing their tasks, and monitoring compliance before participation to Championships.

Dear WAKO Europe Board,



Please let me inform you of the current situation. As you know, during the last Board meeting we decided to ask Francesca to consult Dr. Massimiliano Bianco, chairman of the Medical Committee and discuss the new requirements for the host countries regarding the inclusion of the Older Cadet age group. Dr. Massimiliano Bianco has prepared a COVID protocol and risk assessment document with the assistance of a COVID expert committee member with experience and qualifications. I asked Srđjan to send the questions and requests regarding the protocol and risk assessment document to the two candidates to be filled in 48 hours.

I think that as soon as we get the necessary and satisfactory answers to these, we will not have a difficult task, as the majority has answered our questions in the questionnaire we sent out: the Cadet and Junior European Championship should preferably be held in November and with the inclusion of the Older Cadet age group, hoping that by then, the vaccination rates will have reached the level where the parents are willing to let their children compete and maybe even travel with them. The majority of answers was reached by 28 members answering positively out of the 43.







This is the information I wished to share with you. As soon as we get the answers from the candidates regarding the COVID protocol and risk assessment, we will discuss it in a Board meeting. The answers of the candidates and the written statement and approving review of the Medical Committee and Dr. Massimiliano Bianco will be the basis of our decision. When these documents are received, the Board meeting will have the task of making a decision about the scheduling of this championship to November, the inclusion of the Older Cadets in the championship and about the winner of the bid to host the Cadet and Junior European Championship. After that, we will inform the members and the candidates of the result.

During the meeting, the President of the Federation Orkhan Aliyev, 1th Vice President Efram Majidov, Secretary General and Head

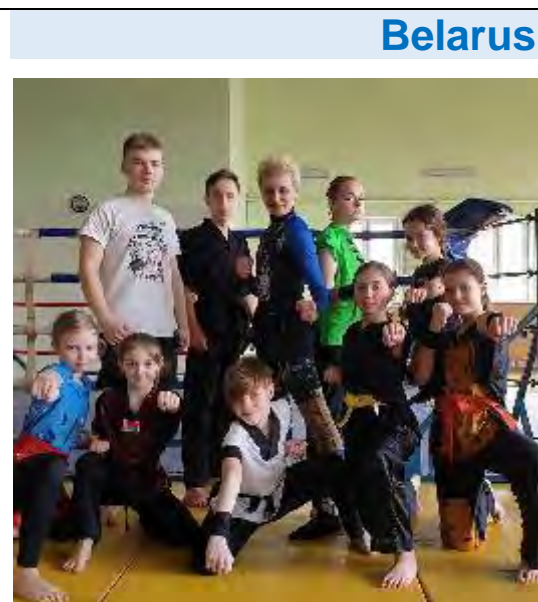
of the National Team Sadikh Bagirov were provided with detailed information about the activities and future plans of the Federation, discussions were held.

The National Championships in the disciplines "K-1" and "Full Contact" in Pazardzhik. The fights was held under the auspices of the Bulgarian Kickboxing and Muay Thai Confederation, and the host for the second year in a row is the local SC "Spartak

Pazardzhik 2014". The huge interest in the competition is impressive: 320 competitors from 52 clubs across the country have applied for participation.

The organizers have also thought about the youngest kickboxers, who are definitely the future champions of Bulgaria in the spectacular martial arts. **More than 40 children are registered to participate in a separate kickboxing tournament in the ring in the discipline of "Low Kick"**.

According to the representatives of BKKMT and the national coach Vladimir Valev, the earlier the kids start competing, the better they will prepare for the far more serious matches in the youth group, and then for the categories for men and women. Thus, children aged 7-8 and 9-10 will gain valuable experience that will be useful for their further development.

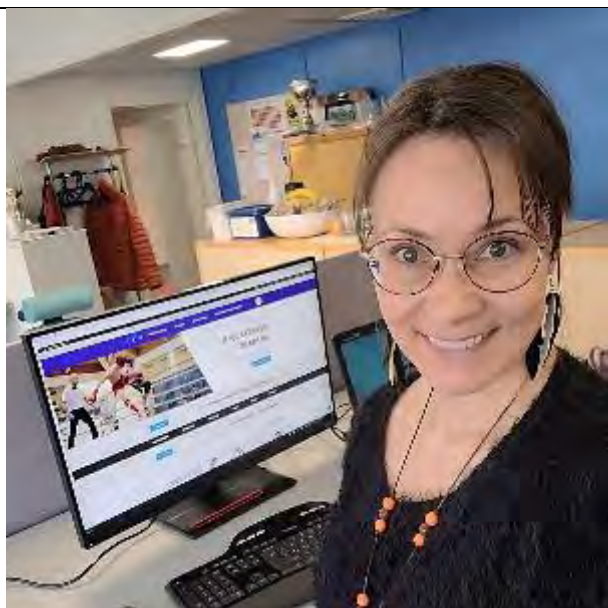


Corona Guidelines with effect from Wednesday, April 21, 2021

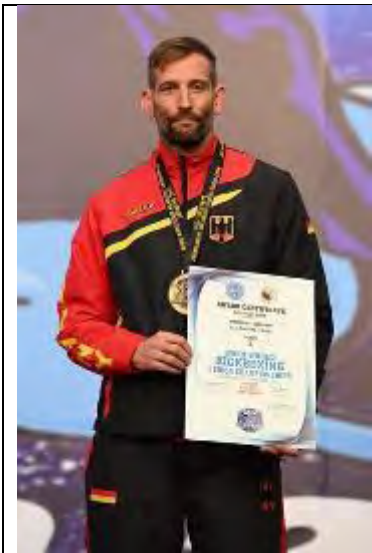

At the beginning of the changes in the rules, as well as the reallocation of the age groups was explained. After warming up together, a technical unit followed and, in parallel, the athletes were individually subjected to a torso stabilization test (according to Bourban).

In the second part, the unit started with a cognitive warm-up, which leads to an increase in concentration as well as the ability to think and react. After the sparring - in different modes (short rounds, task sparring and regular round sparring), everyone had to concentrate and exercise again during an athletic and stretching unit.

The fighters performed well, even if the starting situation was not an easy one. There have been no competitions since March 2020 and sometimes it was not even possible to train together in different federal states during this time. The aim is for everyone to be fit and well prepared for the EM in Hungary, which will hopefully take place in August, and to participate successfully.

This afternoon IMAC President **Brendan Dowling** and Vice-President **Roy Baker** took part in a two and a half hour virtual meeting with Minister for Sport **Jack Chambers** as well as the Sports Monitoring Group, 13 key National Governing Bodies of Sport and 6 Sports Representative bodies.

During the meeting the Minister thanked all the NGBs for the work done over the last year and, in particular, acknowledged the frustration of those involved in in-door sports due to the delay in an opening date being announced yet. Minister Chambers suggested that there was a lot of room for optimism at the moment and that he hoped that we would soon have a timetable for the phased re-opening of indoor sports.

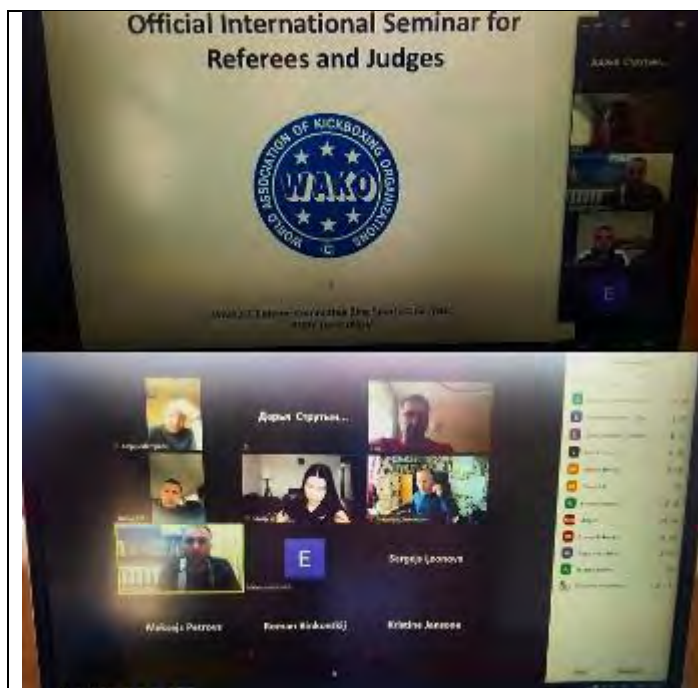

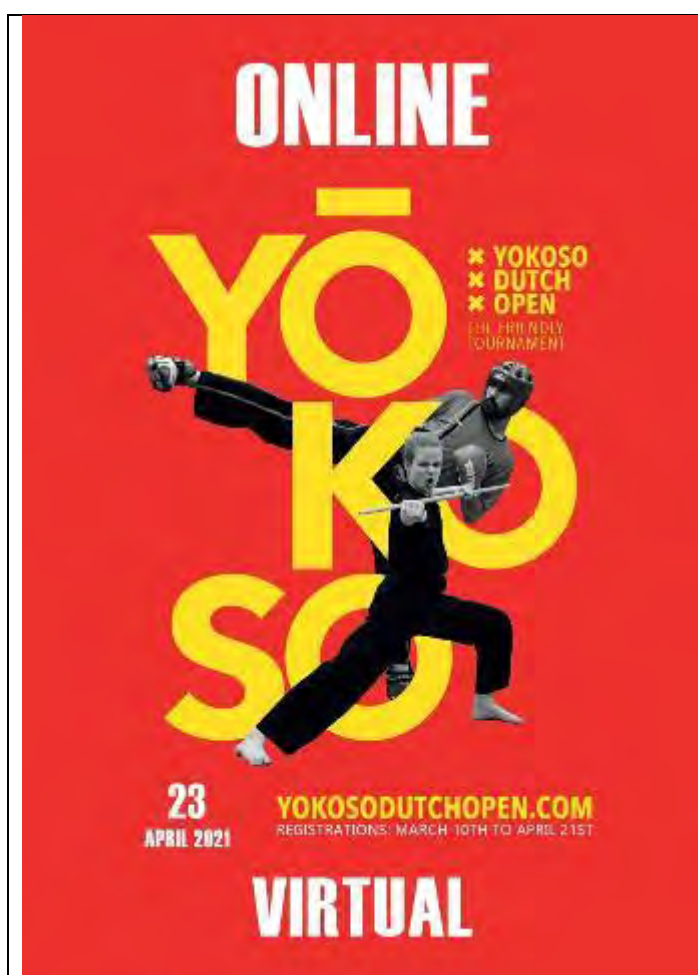




Latvia

Moderate relaxation for adult sports starting April 19.

The Federal Council is informing about further, careful opening steps. In assessing the easing, the Federal Council has also taken into account the social impacts of the pandemic, especially on adolescents and young adults.

The specifications for sports activities are newly relaxed for adults in the amateur area, for individuals or for groups of up to 15 people. Competitions are also allowed under these conditions (only for sports without physical contact). Outside must either be worn a mask or maintain the required distance of 1,5 meters. In the

interiors, both the mask must be worn and the distance must be maintained. However, exemptions are provided for activities where masks cannot be worn, such as endurance training in gyms. Stricter distancing requirements apply in these exceptional cases.



Turkish Open European Cup

The 6th International Turkish Kickboxing European Cup, which was part of the WAKO 2021 Calendar, was held from 08-11 April 2021. There were 388 clubs, 1500 athletes, over 300 trainers, referees and administrators from 15 countries in participation.

The tournament was held according to the European Cup pandemic guidelines. All participants had to have proof of a Covid-19 test before entering the hotel, and those with negative results were permitted to participate in the tournament.

WAKO IF President, Mr. Roy Baker spoke at the opening ceremony. The 6th International Turkish Kickboxing European Cup is the first WAKO event held in a long time due to the pandemic. Mr. Salim Kayici, WAKO IF Vice President, WAKO Europe Vice President and the Turkish Kickboxing Federation President, thanked Mr. Roy Baker and all the participating countries, and clubs for their support of this event.

Kickboxing: Singapore's **Nazri Sutari** among 15 selected for global leadership programme

He won Singapore's first sambo gold medal at the SEA Games after making an 11th hour switch ahead of the 2019 edition in the Philippines, but Nazri Sutari's heart always remained with kickboxing.

With sambo not featuring at the upcoming edition of the Games - kickboxing will - the 30-year-old decided the time was right for a return. He returned to kickboxing training earlier this year after a major knee injury, with an eye on making the cut for Hanoi. Now, he has been given a boost off the mat.



On April 19, 2021, the 2021 Gyeonggi-do Kickboxing Association(GKA) Board Meeting was held at the conference hall of Seongnam Art Center.

On this day, GKA's President, Dr. Euncheon Jeong, received the association's flag from Dr. Jeongho Lee, the former President, and President Dr. Euncheon Jeong appointed former Chairman Dr. Jungho Lee as Honorary President. In addition, President Euncheon Jeong commissioned 25 directors of GKA, and approved four agendas, including the business plan and budget for 2021.

With 14 million people living in Gyeonggi-do, it is made up of 31 cities and is the largest region in Korea. Starting with the meeting of the board of directors on this day, GKA will start the competition, promotion screening, and education business in earnest



03.04.21 - Closing of the 2021 Vietnam National Kickboxing Cup Championship

After more than 10 days of competition, on the evening of April 1, 2021 at Quy Nhon City Square, there were thrilling, attractive and exciting final matches with the encouragement of more than 3,000 fans. The 2021 National Kickboxing Cup Championship has officially ended.

Results of the whole South group:

- First: KickBoxing HCMC - 3 gold medals, 5 silver medals
- Second: Hanoi KickBoxing - 3 gold medals, 1 silver medal, 3 bronze medals.
- Third: Army KickBoxing - 2 gold medals, 2 silver medals, 2 bronze medals.

Women union results:

- First: KickBoxing Thai Nguyen - 3 gold medals, 2 silver medals, 3 bronze medals.
- Second: KickBoxing Hanoi - 3 gold medals, 3 bronze medals.
- Third: KickBoxing Binh Dinh - 2 gold medals, 3 silver medal

This was an important tournament ahead of the 31st SEA Games, scheduled to take place at the end of November 2021 at home.

The athletes have an impressive performance, the opportunity to review their forces to prepare for the next tournament this year.

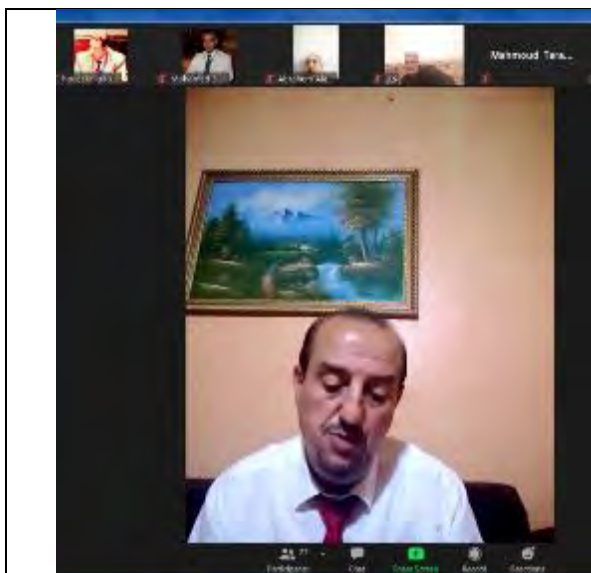

Most of the countries could not attend due to COVID-19 travel restrictions. Congratulations to all that participated.





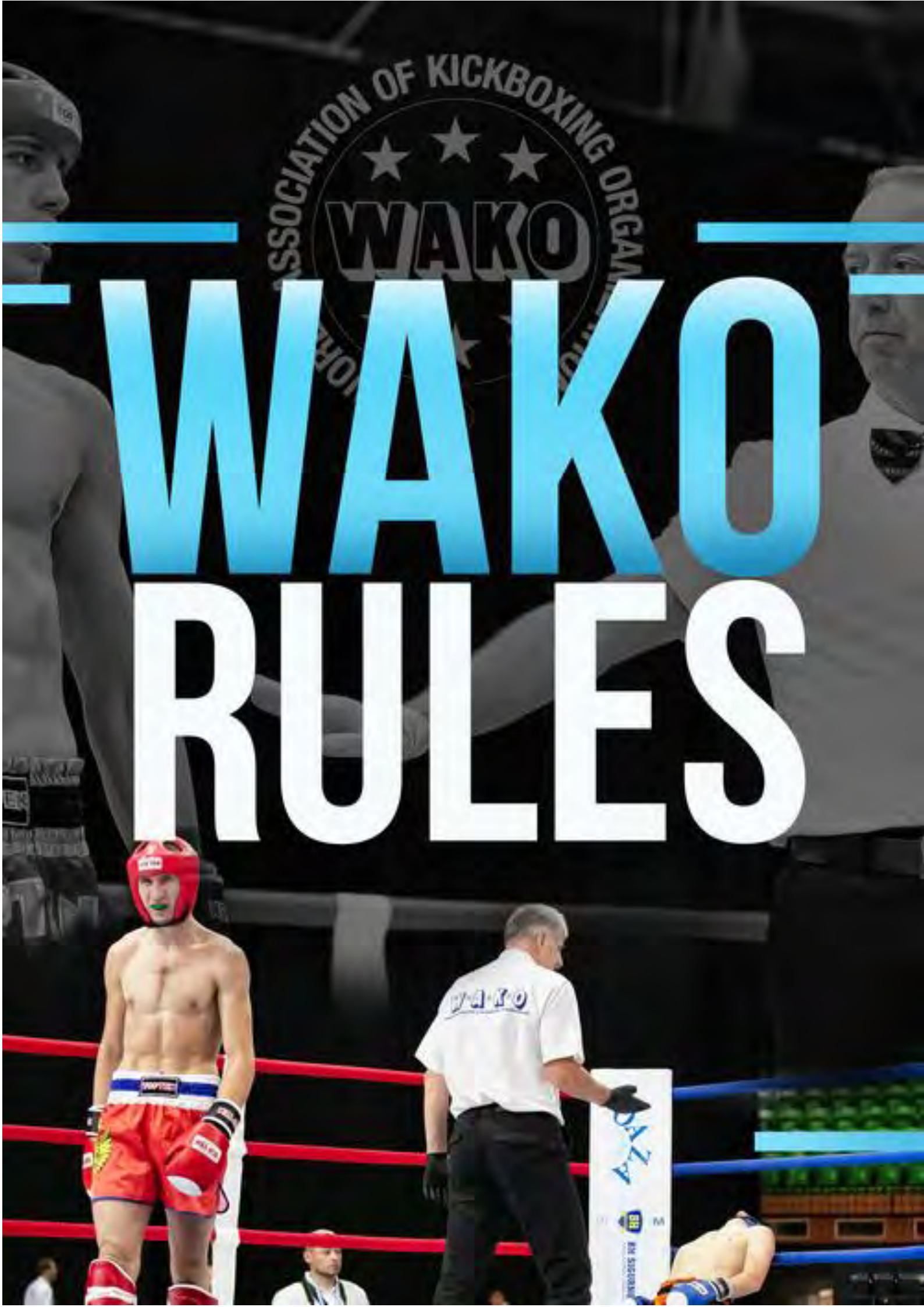

As you know, the WAKO Board has accepted the new WAKO rules and they have been published on the official website. They take effect on January 1st 2021. There is a lot of news, and in this column, we will present you the news and give you a comment and explanations.

Age categories

Introduction and explanation

As we explained in the last issue of the new way of determining age categories, here we repeat the overview of categories for 2021.

The same overview will be in each WAKO Calendar, at the end of the list of activities during the year.

From the new WAKO Rules

Article 2.1.1.2. Age categories

Kickboxers are divided in age and weight categories which are defined in Ring General Rules and Tatami General Rules.

Age is determined by the year of birth.

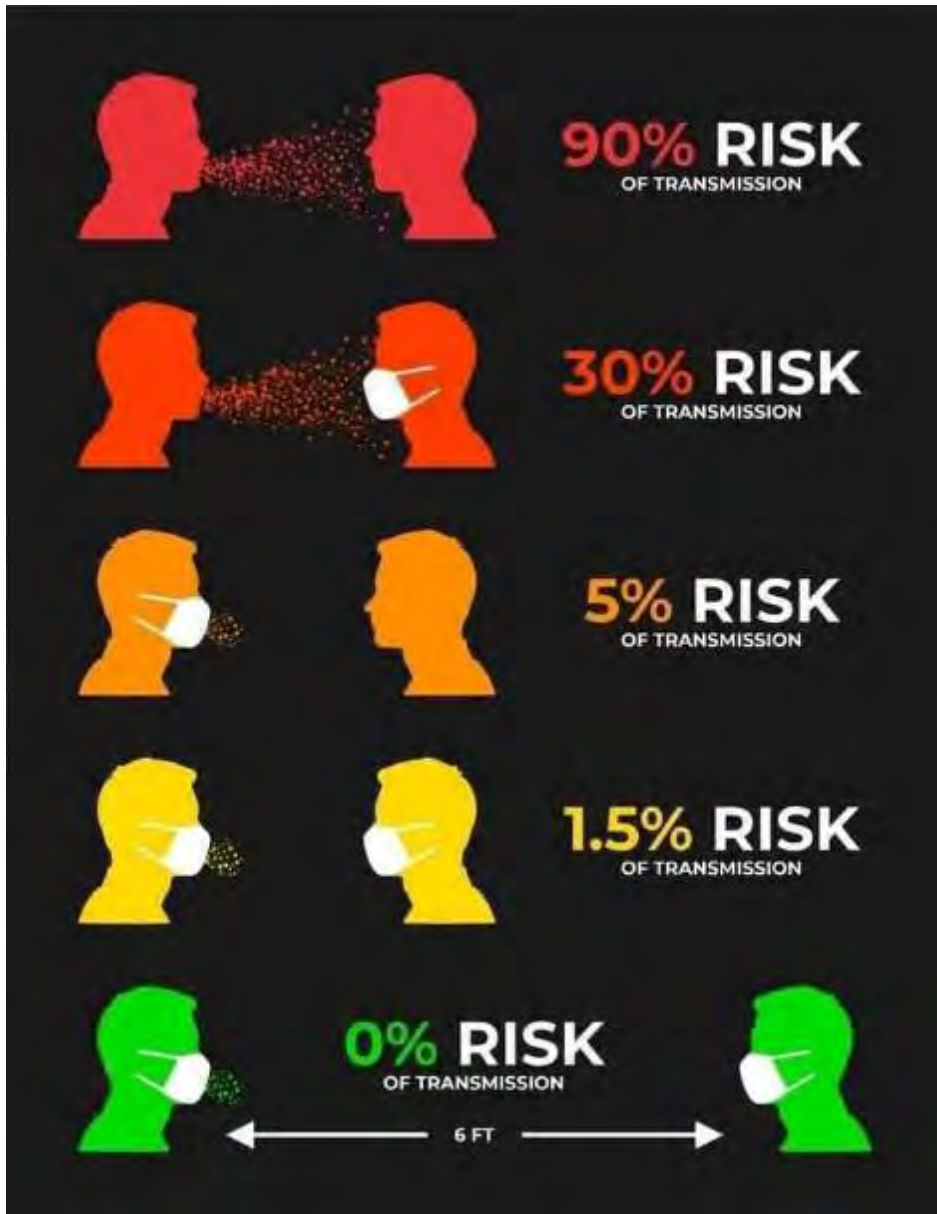

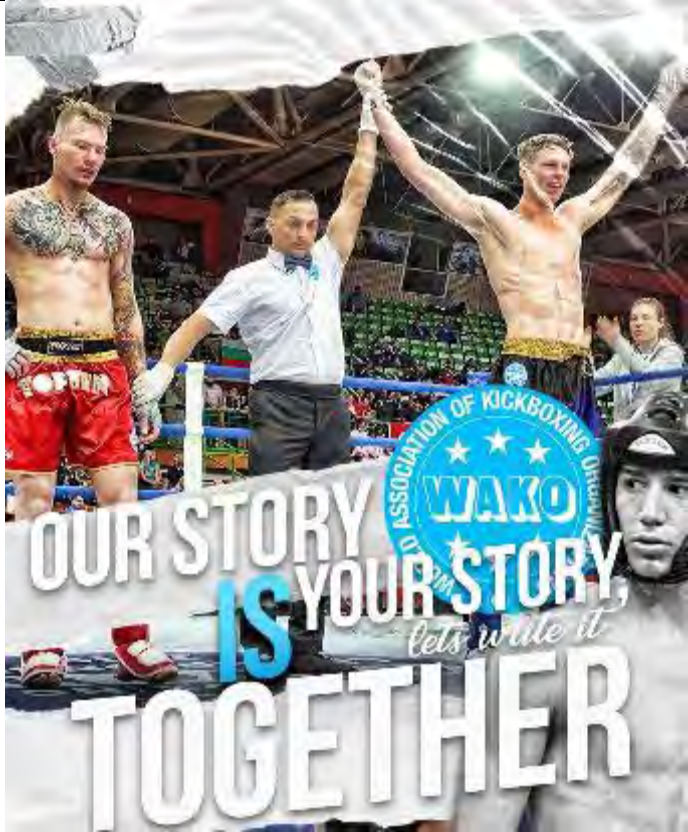
