Phonics	We will upload a daily phonics sound, video link and activity to Dojo. As we are in the revision stages it may seem that we are recovering the same sounds, this is intentional. For those not accessing Dojo
Reading	Create a reading den to read either your school reading book or a book of your choice. You will also find free online books at Oxford Owls (requires a log in but it's definitely free)
Writing	Draw a picture of a character from your favourite story and label it. Describe your character using adjectives. Can you write a caption too?
Maths	Shape hunt. Watch the shape song (see the post with the video links) and make a list of the simple shapes. See if you can find objects to match each shape around the house and garden. Sort these into piles. Can you do the same for 3D shapes?
Art and Creative	Make a band! Use household items to create instruments. These could be home made instruments or objects from around the house like pots and pans. Use the attached sheet to create a sequence of music. Upload your sounds to Dojo or Tapestry.
Understanding the world	Change of state Look into the changes of melting/freezing things such as chocolate or water. Can you predict (guess) what will happen? Can you change it back to the original? What did you need to do?
Physical Development	Fine motor fun! Help with hanging the clothes washing up for the whole week. Use the pegs to strengthen your hand and finger muscles
PSED	Have a skype or facetime call with a relative. Think of some questions you would like to ask them before your call eg What was your favourite thing to do as a child? What was/is your favourite job? What are your parents' names?
Mental health and life skills	Learn how to use the washing machine – load and unload, learn how much soap to put in and then how to turn it on. Ask about the numbers on the dials, what do they mean? What is a cycle? Which cycle do we use the most?
