Maths	<p>Please use Numbots and Purple Mash apps every day. See daily fluency tasks posted to your class story. Practise counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's and ask an adult to test you on random times table questions such as <math>3 \times 5 =</math> See upload of Shape learning for the week on the class story-This includes a powerpoint and tasks,</p>
Writing	<p><b>Story writing focus</b> Day 1 – Plan a story using a story map (we have used these a lot in class. For each part of their story, the children draw a picture, add key adjectives, time connectives and link it to the next part of the story, with an arrow. Alternatively, the children might like to draw a story mountain instead.) Day 2- Write the introduction and build up Day 3 - Write the middle section where the problem unfolds Day 4 - Write the ending and begin to edit your work to make it even better. Remember to edit and improve adding in better word choices. You might like to use an on-line thesaurus. Day 5 - Publish your story. You could write in pen or type your story and include pictures. I would love to read your stories. Please upload story photos to the DOJO, if possible.</p> <p>Login to Purple Mash to use word games and story creating programmes.</p>
Reading	<p>Use Purple Mash and login. Choose a book from Serial Mash. See attached reading comprehension, uploaded to the Class story. Write a book review of each book that you have read, using the book review tool. Remember, statement and question sentence types. You might have a favourite recipe book or Tasty on line have some brilliant videos of step by step ways to make food with children. Select a recipe, make it and take photos to upload to the Class Dojo.</p>
Spelling	<p>Common exception word practise (these are all of the spellings from Autumn term). Read, cover, write, check. Practise writing sentences that include the common exception words. Practise spelling words with the ed, ing, ful, ness, less, tion suffixes (all of these have been taught this term and distributed as weekly spelling tests.)</p>

Science	<p>Log on to Purple Mash and go to science- animals, plants, seasons, human body. There are lots of sections to explore.</p> <p>Do some on-line research about a habitat using BBC learning, National Geographic Kids and also there are some great power points on twinkl.co.uk (a login is currently free to create! There are thousands of resources aimed at year 2).</p>
Art	<p>Self-portrait –use a mirror to look at your facial features. Sketch a picture of yourself. Take a photo of your final pieces and upload them to Class Dojo (this can be done really quickly, using a mobile phone).</p>
PE	<p>CBBC, Go Noodle, Cosmic Kids Yoga and Joe Wicks at 9am are great sites to use. You could design your own work out- ten of everything- 10 star jumps, sit ups, jogging on the spot, balances etc. Write a workout using instructions and video and upload your workout to Class Dojo.</p> <p>Create your own game. Write instructions and play as a family.</p>
Geography	<p>Use an atlas or online research to locate forests in the UK. Create a poster, using pictures, labels, captions, fact boxes.</p>
