Reading	<p>Aim to do one task per day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go to Purple Mash and log in. Choose a book to read from Serial Mash. Complete the follow up activities after reading each chapter.</li><li>• Pick a book from your bookshelf and read a chapter or two – record this in your reading diary.</li><li>• Create a book review for a book you have read. Share a book review by email or on dojo.</li><li>• Design a new cover front and back (including the blurb) for your favourite book.</li></ul>
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go to Purple Mash and log in. Find '2Do: Space Traveller' in your alerts. Imagine you have just travelled to one of the planets in our solar system. Write a postcard to your friend about what you have seen and what you have been doing ensuring it includes some <b>specific details from your chosen planet</b>.</li><li>• Look at Pobble 365 website for a picture to write about daily, share you work on dojo or email. If you click on the drop down arrow you can find different activities to try, like Story starter, Question Time, Sick Sentence, Sentence Challenge or Perfect Picture <a href="http://www.pobble365.com/">http://www.pobble365.com/</a></li><li>• Start a diary and add to it about all the things you are doing at home. You will be able to share this with people in the future and talk about the time when schools had to close down.</li></ul>
Spelling Punctuation and Grammar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go to Purple Mash and log in. Find '2Do: George Misbehaves' in your Alerts (the purple bell). See if you can add the correct prefixes to the words. When you're done, click the red exit arrow and click 'Hand in'.</li></ul>
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Times Tables Rock Stars – what will this week's tournament be?</li><li>• Maths fluency tasks will be shared on Class Dojo through the week</li><li>• Play <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button</a> - have a go at the different types of questions and challenge yourself</li><li>• Log into Purple Mash where you will find Monster multiplication in your alerts. These games will help keep your tables knowledge up to speed.</li></ul>

Discuss why. How would this change in on the Moon. Topic & Art	<p>2 week project! Week 2. Finish creating a poster about our solar system</p> <p>Try to answer these questions on your poster:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is the Sun?</li> <li>• How many planets are there in the Solar System?</li> <li>• What order are the planets from the Sun?</li> <li>• What are the sizes and shape of the planets?</li> <li>• Which is the largest planet in our solar system?</li> </ul> <p>You could also find out about future space exploration!</p>
Computing	<p>Go to Purple Mash and log in. Find '2Do: Internet Safety' and '2Do: e safety poster' in your alerts.</p> <p>After sorting the phrases in '2Do: Internet Safety', then design a poster to help children stay safe on the internet whilst doing their home learning. You could include some of the SMART rules or make up your own. Make it eye catching and include lots of useful information.</p> 
Physical fitness	<p>How about making up your own dance routine to your favourite song?
