

Easter activities Year 2

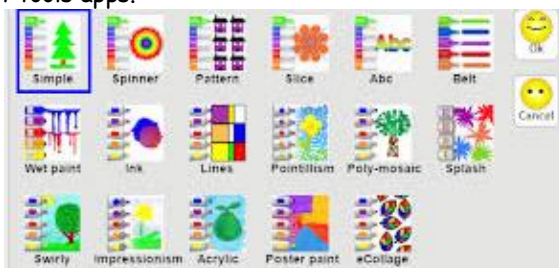
Design and create your own Easter Card

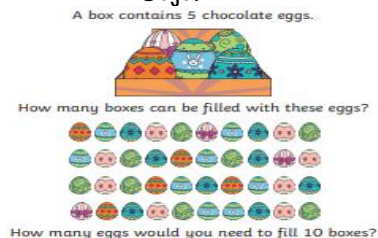
Easter grammar, spelling and writing work out booklet
