Reading	Extreme Reading Challenge Submit two photos of yourself reading in 'extreme' circumstances. One of these could be photo-shopped (if you are able to) or they can be from around the home.
Writing	Over the Easter holidays, we would like to challenge you to get creative and write a poem based on spring time. Use the 'Poem Help Powerpoint' to look at examples from 'The Lost Word's Poems' and get some ideas. Your challenge is to choose a plant or animal relating to spring, and write your own poem about it, drawing inspiration from <i>The Lost Words</i> poems that you have read. Start by choosing your subject and mind-mapping everything that it reminds you of.
PSHE	You may have noticed lots of rainbows appearing in people windows, which have been created to spread a positive message and lift peoples spirits. So, if you have not already done so, it's time to get crafty with an A4 piece of paper creating you prettiest rainbows and messages of positivity. When you're done, place them in your window so that others can enjoy them too.
Maths	There will be new battle set up across all of year 6 – girls vs boys. Go to TT Rockstars and login. Take part in any TT game and earn points. We'll be keeping an eye on who's improving their times to house points. We will also set some of the maths games as 2Do's on Purple Mash for you.
Topic and Art	Easter challenges: - Try making a sweet treat to share with your family. We would love to see a photo or picture of any treats you make. - Try making a model basket to hold some Easter treats! You could use an empty cardboard box and decorate it with paints or colourful Easter pictures. - Egg starts with the letter 'e' – what else starts with the letter 'e'? Write a list of as many things that start with the letter 'e'. 1 house point for every ten you can think of! - Have a go at some of the Lego challenges (see below).
