

WALT: use the determiners **a** or **an** to introduce a noun.

Key Words:

Determiner: a word that introduces a noun (e.g. **a** dog)

Noun: a person, place, object, or thing (e.g. a **dog**).

General rule: if your noun begins with a vowel (aeiou), you need to use **an**. If your noun begins with a consonant (bcdfghjklmnpqrstvwxyz), you need to use **a**. However, there are some exceptions!

Use the determiner **a** or **an** to complete our shopping list.

When I went to the shops, I bought...

a chocolate teapot,

— apple

— three-legged monster

— pizza made from jelly

— pocket-sized elephant

— orange sandwich

— ice cream on toast

— umbrella with holes

— ostrich egg

— pair of shoes made from cheese

— hat for a goldfish
