

Hello Year 1's, welcome to Week 2 of Summer Term 2 – Monday 8th June 2020

The activities below are variations of what we had planned to do in school this week following the skills from the National Curriculum.

Reading	<p>Practice reading your school reading book and others you have at home.</p> <p>Use Oxford Owl (https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/) to sign up for a free account, which gives you access to a range of ebooks that match their school reading level.</p> <p>Online phonics games are available on Phonics Play https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/ they currently have all resources free when you use this login. Username: march20 password: home.</p> <p>We have attached a reading comprehension task about Sunflowers. There are 3 different levels please scan through and select the appropriate level for your child. We have also provided answers at the end.</p>
Writing	<p>We would like you to write your own story this week using the knowledge of the 5 part story we looked at last term. You could split this up into sections if you wish for example; On Monday write the beginning, Tuesday the build-up, Wednesday the problem/middle, Thursday the resolution and Friday the ending. If your children can write in longer periods then feel free to complete quicker. You could do this on Purple Mash or handwritten.</p>
Maths	<p>This week we would like you to recap on counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s and begin to apply this knowledge when multiplying by 2, 5 and 10.</p> <p>There are a variety of tasks to complete on the document attached on Dojo with a short explanation of how you can work it out. Don't forget you can use objects at home to help you with your counting.</p>
Science	<p>In Science we would be looking at parts of a tree, following on from last terms identification of the trees. On Purple Mash there is a 2Do activity about evergreen and deciduous trees to recap this. We have also attached a sheet to see if you can label the parts of a tree.</p>
Geography	<p>We would like you to recap on the 7 continents and the 4 countries of the UK. Please log into Purple Mash to complete two quizzes on this. If you wish to explore more of the 4 countries go to BBC Bitesize https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z9grd2p/resources/1 and have an adventure with Barnaby Bear.</p>
RE	<p>In RE we are continuing to think about the question "How should we care for others and the world and why does it matter?"</p> <p>Can you think about the jobs that people do that help look after the world? For example; a gardener looks after living plants and trees or house hold waste collectors helping looking after the environment. What other jobs help us care for the world? What do you do to help?</p>
Physical fitness	<p>Mrs Lawes has been posting some lovely challenges on the whole school dojo please have a look. Remember you can use Joe Wicks or Cosmic Kids on Youtube if you want more suggestions.</p>
PSHE/Mental wellbeing.	<p>Healthy eating.</p> <p>Please look at BBC Bitesize https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zrd4d2p for general information on healthy eating then play the sorting game from the power point from Twinkl. Don't worry if you can't play the game as it is from the power point, use it to discuss with your children.</p>
