

Hello Year 3s!

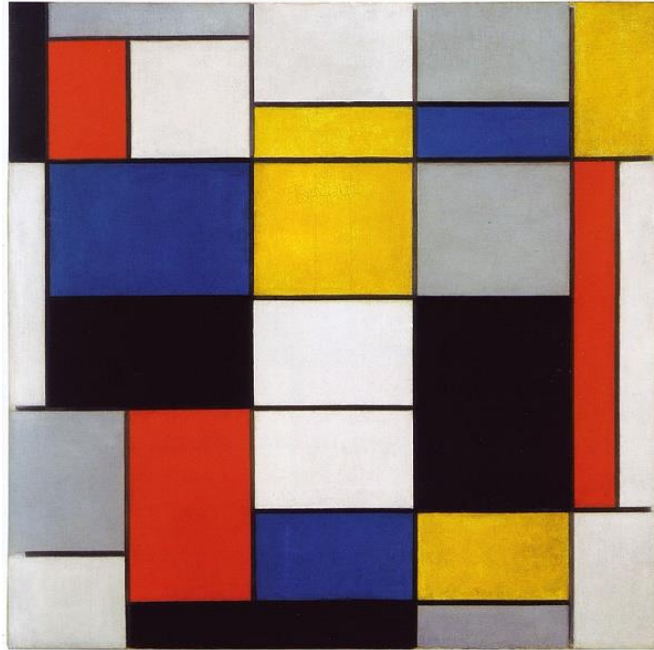
