<p>Reading</p>	<p>Aim to do one task per day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go to Purple Mash and log in. Continue to read the book you started from Serial Mash. Complete the follow up activities after reading each chapter. If you finish you can start a new book. Visit https://www.natgeokids.com/uk/kids-club/cool-kids/general-kids-club/plastic-pollution/ and read the article about plastic pollution. Make a poster highlighting some of the key facts, the problems plastic is causing in our oceans and what we can do to help stop the pollution. Go to https://literacytrust.org.uk/family-zone/9-12/book-hopes/ for a book of short stories and poems called 'The Book of Hopes'. Pick a story/poem to read aloud to a member of your family. How does it make you feel? What did you like or dislike? Home reading - record this in your reading diary.
<p>Writing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Using the article https://www.natgeokids.com/uk/kids-club/cool-kids/general-kids-club/plastic-pollution/ from the reading above, can you write a letter to the government outlining your concerns about water pollution? Make your letter persuasive by remembering the features we used in our letter to Mr Pajak e.g. rhetorical questions, ambiguity, exaggeration, statistics, emotive language. We know you love to watch YouTube. Imagine you are a world famous Youtuber. Write a script about a topic which enthuses you either on paper and send it to us or use the assigned 2Do file on Purple Mash. You may find the attached file helps you to structure your piece and if you'd like to film it too, we'd love to see it. Continue writing in your home diary or send us (by email) a diary entry. Continue to use the Covid-19 Time Capsule PDF to record your thoughts and what you have been doing to remember this unprecedented time.

Go to Purple Mash and log in. Find '2Do -Year 5 Sum 2 to test yourself on the first 10 Yr5/6 statutory words.
<p>Maths</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Times Tables Rock Stars - see if you can get yourself in the top 30 on the leaderboard - knock some of the teachers off! You have to be in studio in order to do this. Choose a Problem of the Day (attached file) to solve. Some of the questions are using Year 6 knowledge but challenge yourself to have a go. No cheating - the answers are provided for you to check your work. Log into Purple Mash where you will find '2Do: Common factors, multiples and Primes and Fractionio's Pizza' in your alerts. Work through the tasks in Can DO Maths 5.8 throughout the week - do a task or 2 each day

<p>Topic</p>	<p>Ancient Greeks <u>The Olympics</u> continued Remember what you learned last week about the particular events that were held at the Ancient Olympic Games. Find out which events are still played at the Olympics today. What legacy has been left behind? List Ancient Greek Olympic events and Modern Olympic events.</p> <p>What were the rules of the Ancient Olympic Games? For example participants, rules and locations. Can you create a chart comparing the Olympics today to the Olympics in Ancient Greece?</p> <p>Look specifically at the events, participants, rules and locations etc. Discuss what has changed.</p> <p>Web links:</p>
