Maths

Reading

Writing

Each day, choose at least one of the skills tasks to complete – different tenses, formal and informal speech, synonyms and antonyms or a grammar and punctuation quiz.

Then choose one of the creative writing tasks and write a paragraph that shows what writing skills you remember from last term.

You should complete one skills task and write one paragraph from the creative writing tasks each day. You can complete more if you wish.
