

## Year 6 Home Learning overview – First 48 hours

Maths	<p>There is a selection of activities for you to choose from that recap the learning we did last term – ordering numbers, calculating missing angles, negative numbers, a place value booklet and a set of arithmetic questions.</p> <p>Each day you should choose a least one of the activities to complete (or one page of the place value booklet) and 5 different arithmetic questions. You can complete more if you wish.</p> <p>You can either print the work if you are able or copy it on paper. When you have finished you can take a picture and upload it on to your portfolio on Dojo to share with your teacher.</p>
Reading	<p>Choose a book you have read or are currently reading, either your school book or one you have at home. There is a list of different reading tasks for you to complete, please choose and complete one task each day. You may complete more if you wish.</p> <p>You can either type your work using a computer or use pen a paper. When you have finished you can take a picture and upload it on to your portfolio on Dojo to share with your teacher or upload your document if you typed it.</p>
Writing	<p>Each day, choose at least one of the skills tasks to complete – different tenses, formal and informal speech, synonyms and antonyms or a grammar and punctuation quiz.</p> <p>Then choose one of the creative writing tasks and write a paragraph that shows what writing skills you remember from last term.</p> <p>You should complete one skills task and write one paragraph from the creative writing tasks each day. You can complete more if you wish.</p> <p>You can either type your work using a computer or use pen a paper. When you have finished you can take a picture and upload it on to your portfolio on Dojo to share with your teacher or upload your document if you typed it.</p>
