

WALT multiply a 1-digit number by a decimal (2dp)

Remember your decimal point in your answer - this is really important or your answer may be 10 or 100 times too big!

Do it

1) $8 \times 1.25 =$

2) $3 \times 2.31 =$

3) $3 \times 2.45 =$

4) $1.25 \times 7 =$

5) $4.45 \times 8 =$

6) $8.54 \times 6 =$

Secure it

Mrs Wilkins thinks that:

$$6 \times 2.34 = 1404$$

Is she correct? Explain your thinking and provide the correct answer if she is incorrect.

Deepen it

Always Sometimes/ Never

The product of a 1 digit number and a decimal number with 2 decimal places is a decimal number with 2 decimal places.
